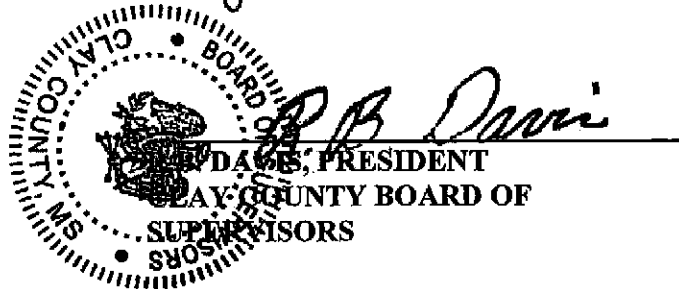

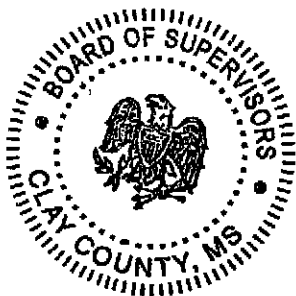
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There came on this day for consideration the matter of establishing the times and places by which this Board shall hold meetings in 2019.
