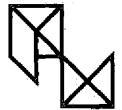

PART 3-EXECUTION

3.01 INSTALLATION OF SYSTEMS

A. Locate all items requiring adjustments, cleaning, or similar attention so that it will be accessible for such attention. Equipment racks shall be positioned so as to permit full access for operation and service.

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- B. Furnish and install brackets, braces, and supports. Minimum fastening or safety factor shall be at least five (5). Design shall be to the approval of the Architect.

3.02 ELECTRICAL POWER

- A. Review and coordinate electrical power system installation with architect.
- B. Verify all AC circuits designated for audio systems are wired with correct polarity and properly grounded. Report any discrepancies to Architect in writing for corrective action.

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C. Contractor is to provide distribution of electrical power within audio equipment racks.

3.03 SUPPORTS

A. Fabricate and install any supports so that the installation does not weaken or overload the building structure. Do not impose the weight of equipment or fixtures on supports provided for other trades or systems. No drilling or cutting of concrete beams, joists, or structural steel, no welding to structural steel will be permitted except as authorized, in writing by the Architect.

3.04 BOXES

- A. All boxes, conduits, cabinets, equipment and related wiring shall be held in place and the mounting shall be plumb and square. (portable equipment excluded)
- B. All boxes shall be installed so that wiring contained in them is accessible. Install blanking devices or threaded plugs in all unused holes.
- C. Wiring groups and circuits shall be isolated as indicated herein. Common pull or junction boxes are not permitted except as authorized, in writing, by the audio Designer.
- D. Clean all box interiors before installing plates, panels, or covers.

3.05 WIRING METHODS AND PRACTICES

- A. Provide installation of all A/V wire and cable, ensuring proper:

 - 2. Quantities

 - 4. Lengths
 - 5. Routing
 - 6. Wire Group Separation
 - 7. Identification
- B. Interconnection of all audio equipment requiring shielded cable shall be West Penn 452 or equivalent, unless otherwise specified.
- Splicing of cables is not permitted between terminations of specified equipment.
- D. Provide wire pulling lubricants and pulling tensions in accordance with the wire and cable manufacturer's recommendations.
- E. All wire shall be permanently identified at each end with labeling and clear heat shrink or "Brady" type labels. A chart shall be kept of each wires function. This chart shall be part of the system documentation.

3.10 VERIFICATION TEST REPORT

A. Submit 3 copies of a written report detailing the results of initial adjustments and verification tests including all relevant drawing, charts, and photographs. This report shall be completed and submitted to the Audio Designer at least 5 days prior to Acceptance testing and final tuning.

3.11 ACCEPTANCE TESTING (COMMISSIONING)

- A. Acceptance testing shall be performed by the architect during a period determined by the Architect, designer, and contractor. Contractor shall furnish two (2) technicians for the acceptance testing period.
- B. Contractor is to coordinate testing period so that there is free access to the venue and appropriate work light and electrical power are on site. Air handling systems shall be functioning and on. Acoustical conditions shall be the same as when the venue is in actual use.
- C. A/V contractor will bear any cost incurred for additional time and/or visits by the architect due to contractor's failure to have the system functioning in accordance with the contract documents at the time scheduled for acceptance testing and tuning. (typical cost per day for commissioning is approx. \$750.00 plus travel expenses)
- D. Provide one (1) copy of the operation and maintenance manual to the architect at the time of acceptance testing.

3.12 SYSTEM DOCUMENTATION

A. Within thirty (30) days of the acceptance testing, prepare and submit five (5) neatly bound copies of the operation and maintenance manuals to the Owner. These copies are in addition to the one copy provided to the Audio Designer during acceptance testing.

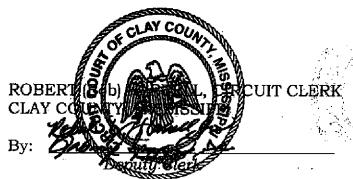
