INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between CLAY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI (the "County"), a political subdivision of the State of Mississippi, acting by and through its duly elected and serving Board of Supervisors, and the CITY OF WEST POINT, MISSISSIPPI (the "City"), a municipal corporation of the State of Mississippi, acting by and through its duly elected and serving Board of Mayor and Selectmen.

RECITALS:

- 1. The County and City are authorized pursuant to Sections 17-13-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Interlocal Act"), to contract with each other for joint and cooperative action relating to the funding and construction of certain road improvements which would otherwise be within the individual authority of the County and City.
- 2. The County is authorized to construct and maintain roads and streets within any municipality of the County. Mississippi Code Annotated §65-7-85, §65-7-74 and §19-3-40. Also see Mississippi Attorney General Opinion No. 2011-00067 (A.G. Op. Adams March 3, 2011). The City is authorized to construct and maintain roads, streets and sidewalks within its municipal boundaries. Mississippi Code Annotated §21-37-39 (all of the foregoing being the "Road Authority").
- 3. West Church Hill Rd. (the "Road") is an existing road constructed by the County at a time when the Road was located outside the municipal boundaries of the City. Subsequently, the City annexed the area and the Road is now within the City.
 - 4. Over the years, both the City and the County have maintained the Road.
- 5. The Road is an important thoroughfare, carrying significant vehicular traffic. Companies employing over 800 workers utilize the Road for business access, including the transport of goods and materials, and employee travel.
- 6. The County and City have determined that the existing vehicular traffic and the Road's importance for economic development merit Road improvements estimated to cost \$997,000 and which shall include base repair and roadway structure strengthening (the "Road Project").
- 7. The County and City desire to work together to obtain grants and provide funding for the Road Project and to construct the same, with the County serving as lead agency for Road construction. To that end, the County and City desire to and do enter into this Agreement wherein the County and City agree to fund (or secure funding) and construct the Road Project pursuant to the terms set forth herein.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the Recitals and the mutual promises, agreements and covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration each to the other given, and intending that the obligations set forth herein are valid and legal obligations of each party, the County and City mutually agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Duration</u>. This Agreement shall be in force and effect from the Effective Date (as defined below) until the Road Project has been completed and accepted by the County, all grants received, and all payments have been made.
- 2. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Agreement is to define the responsibilities of the County and City with respect to the funding and construction of and payment for the Road Project.
- 3. <u>Statutory Authority</u>. The County and City are each authorized to engage in road construction under the Road Authority as described in Recital 2 above. The County and City are each authorized to enter into and fulfill the terms of this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Act, as described in Recital 1 above.
- 4. <u>The Road Project</u>. The Road Project is described in the engineering report plans and specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "A," as may be amended from time to time, and will be constructed following the appropriate approval, advertisement, acceptance of bids, and execution of contracts to construct the Road Project in accordance with statutory and other requirements for the use and expenditure of public funds.
- 5. <u>Administration</u>. This Agreement shall be administered as a joint undertaking of the County and City. A separate entity is not created under this Agreement.
 - a) <u>Lead Agency</u>. The County is designated as the lead agency assigned the responsibility for administration of this joint undertaking, and the Chancery Clerk is hereby designated as the officer to receive, disburse and account for the funds contributed for this undertaking and payments made for the Road Project in the manner prescribed by law.
 - b) <u>Funding</u>. The cost of the Road Project, currently estimated to be \$997,000, will be funded as follows:
 - (i) The County will obtain and contribute a grant in the amount of \$240,000 from the Appalachian Regional Commission.
 - (ii) The County will obtain and contribute a Small Municipal and Limited Population Counties Grant from the Mississippi Development Authority in the amount of \$150,000.
 - (iii) The City will obtain and contribute \$500,000 from the 2018 Transportation and Infrastructure Improvements Fund, as

- appropriated for the Road Project by Section 24(s) of Senate Bill 3049, 2019 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature, and signed into law by the Governor.
- (iv) The balance of Road Project construction costs not funded pursuant to Sections 5(a)(i)-(iii) above will be equally divided between the County and City and contributed from the general fund or special road fund of each, as appropriate.

c) <u>Construction</u>.

- (i) As lead agency, the County will be solely responsible for the finalization of plans and specifications and the approval, advertisement, acceptance of bids, execution of construction contracts, oversight of construction, and payments to the contractor in accord with statutory and other requirements for the use and expenditure of public funds.
- (ii) The County will keep the City reasonably informed of the activities set forth in subsection 5(c)(i) above.
- (iii) In the event the construction bids exceed the estimate of \$997,000, the County and City will confer and agree on the action to take, such as cost reductions through modification of Road Project scope, re-bidding or acceptance of a bid which exceeds the estimate, all in accord with statutory requirements. The County shall not accept a bid in excess of the estimate without the prior written consent of the City.

d) <u>Accounting, Payments and Approvals</u>.

- (i) Prior to the construction contract award, the County will provide details of the construction contract(s), including construction costs and the timetable of construction payments.
- (ii) At the time of construction contract award, the County and City will establish a formula, approved by the Board of Supervisors and Board of Mayor and Selectmen, approving the contract and establishing a formula and timetable for the payment of project costs by the County and City.
- (iii) Upon receipt of payment requests from the contractor, the County Engineer will promptly review the same, determine whether each is proper and payable, and, upon approval by the County, transmit a copy of the same to the City together with an itemized invoice documenting the City's share of the payment to the contractor. Any payments to be made from the City general fund, as provided

in Section 5(b)(iv) above, will be made to the County promptly after receipt and approval by the Board of Mayor and Selectmen.

- (iv) After the County's approval of a payment request and transmittal to the City, the County and/or City will promptly request disbursement of grant or other funding for the same. If the payment request is within the construction cost and timetable previously approved by the City, the Mayor, City Clerk and City Chief Administrative Officer are authorized to immediately request grant funds, subject to ratification by the City at the next regular meeting of the Board of Mayor and Selectmen.
- (v) Upon receipt of grant funds by the City, the City will promptly convey the same to the County for payment of Road Project construction expenses.
- (vi) The County will pay all accepted Road Project payment requests as promptly as possible.
- (vii) The County will make available to the City all reports provided by the construction contractor and the County's engineer. The County will provide to the City a monthly accounting of each expenditure report of the Road Project and a final accounting at the conclusion of the Road Project.
- 6. <u>Amendment</u>. This Agreement may be amended by mutual written consent of the County and the City.
- 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Agreement shall become effective from and after the date (i) it has been approved by the governing authorities of the County and City and executed by the parties hereto using multiple counterparts, and (ii) approved by the Attorney General of the State of Mississippi and filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Mississippi and Chancery Clerk of Clay County, in compliance with the Interlocal Act.
