I am pleased to inform you that based on and in reliance upon the information and materials provided by Clay County, the Center for Tech and Civic Life ("CTCL"), a nonprofit organization tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") section 501(c)(3), has decided to award a grant to support the work of Clay County ("Grantee").

The following is a description of the grant:

AMOUNT OF GRANT: \$6,000.00 USD

PURPOSE: The grant funds must be used exclusively for the public purpose of planning and operationalizing safe and secure election administration in Clay County in 2020 ("Purpose").

Before CTCL transmits these funds to Grantee, CTCL requires that Grantee review and sign this agreement ("Grant Agreement") and agree to use the grant funds in compliance with the Grant Agreement and with United States tax laws and the laws and regulations of your state and jurisdiction ("Applicable Laws"). Specifically, by signing this letter Grantee certifies and agrees to the following:

1. Grantee is a local government unit or political subdivision within the meaning of IRC section 170(c)(1).
2. This grant shall be used only for the Purpose described above, and for no other purposes.

3. Grantee has indicated that the amount of the grant shall be expended on the following specific election administration needs: Personal protective equipment (PPE) for staff, poll workers, or voters, Poll worker recruitment funds, hazard pay, and/or training expenses, Polling place rental and cleaning expenses for early voting or Election Day, and Temporary staffing. Grantee may allocate grant funds among those needs, or to other public purposes listed in the grant application, without further notice to or permission of CTCL.
4. Grantee shall not use any part of this grant to make a grant to another organization, except in the case where the organization is a local government unit or political subdivision within the meaning of IRC section 170(c)(1) or a nonprofit organization tax-exempt under IRC section 501(c)(3), and the subgrant is intended to accomplish the Purpose of this grant. Grantee shall take reasonable steps to ensure that any such subgrant is used in a manner consistent with the terms and conditions of this Grant Agreement, including requiring that subgrantee agrees in writing to comply with the terms and conditions of this Grant Agreement.
5. The grant project period of June 15, 2020 through December 31, 2020 represents the dates between which covered costs may be applied to the grant. The Grantee shall expend the amount of this grant for the Purpose by December 31, 2020.
6. Grantee is authorized to receive this grant from CTCL and certifies that (a) the receipt of these grant funds does not violate any Applicable Laws, and (b) Grantee has taken all required, reasonable and necessary steps to receive, accept and expend the grant in accordance with the Purpose and Applicable Law.
7. The Grantee shall produce a brief report explaining and documenting how grant funds have been expended in support of the activities described in paragraph 3. This report shall be sent to CTCL no later than January 31, 2021 in a format approved by CTCL and shall include with the report a signed certification by Grantee that it has complied with all terms and conditions of this Grant Agreement.
8. This grant may not supplant previously appropriated funds. The Grantee shall not reduce the budget of the Circuit Clerk ("the Election Department") or fail to appropriate or provide previously budgeted funds to the Election Department for the term of this grant. Any amount supplanted, reduced or not provided in contravention of this paragraph shall be repaid to CTCL up to the total amount of this grant.
9. CTCL may discontinue, modify, withhold part of, or ask for the return all or part of the grant funds if it determines, in its sole judgment, that (a) any of the above terms and conditions of this grant have not been met, or (b) CTCL is required to do so to comply with applicable laws or regulations.
10. The grant project period of June 15, 2020 through December 31, 2020 represents the dates between which covered costs for the Purpose may be applied to the grant.



Hi Dylan,

I just wanted to let you know how very much we appreciated the \$21, 210.00 grant. We used the grant money for personal protective equipment, poll worker hazard pay and training expenses, polling cleaning expenses, and temporary staffing. The item probably the most appreciated was that each of the fourteen precincts has a cleaner. I will have my grant report submitted by January 31, 2021. We were able to spend the entire grant for the election.

Clay County is a small county in east central Mississippi. We have around 14,500 registered voters. We have five election commissioners representing the five supervisors districts. We work

an average of two to three days a week, except for during an election. Two of the election commissioners have computers that are equipped with Windows 10, the other three have computers equipped with Windows 7 or XP. We have asked for new computers, but were told there was no money. We know that the computers we are using could be a security threat to the registered voters.

If anyone that received the grant doesn't use it, we would really appreciate if you could give the money to our county. We have researched and discovered that we can buy the computers that we need for \$1,200.00 each. That would only be \$6,000.00. If you had money not allotted, or use, we could certainly use it and would really appreciate it.

**CLAY COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICT FOUR
ROAD BOND AGREEMENT**

MADE AND ENTERED INTO this 22nd day of October, 2020 by and between Clay County, Mississippi, Supervisor District Four, hereinafter referred to as "Clay County Supervisor District Four", and Austin Logging, LLC, of 15 Robbs Road, Randolph, Mississippi 38864 hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

WHEREAS, Contractor, through its agents, subcontractors and/or assigns, is desirous of using the west portion of Randle Road, Una Brand Road and Highway 145 in Clay County, Mississippi, such roadways being under the supervision and control of Clay County Supervisor District Four, for the purpose of cutting and hauling away timber using trucks and other forms of heavy equipment.

WHEREAS, Clay County Supervisor District Four is willing to permit the movement of Contractor's trucks over the hereinafter described roads of Clay County Supervisor District Four according to the terms and conditions of this agreement:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing representations, which Contractor specifically acknowledges and adopts, and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree for themselves, their successors and assigns, as follows:

Clay County Supervisor District Four, as of the effective date of this Agreement, hereby allows Contractor to utilize the above described road(s) located in Clay County Supervisor District Four for the purposes set forth above and for no other, for a period of sixty (60) days from the date shown in the first paragraph of this agreement.

Clay County Supervisor District Four and Contractor hereby agree the roads listed in this agreement have been inspected prior to commencement of hauling over the same by Contractor and that the condition of said road(s), as of the date of this agreement, shall be incorporated into this Agreement by reference and/or photographs and are made a part hereof.

Contractor, at the completion of its operations, shall immediately submit to Shelton Deanes, Supervisor of Clay County Supervisor District Four, or his designated agent written notice of said completion. As soon as possible after receipt of such notice Shelton Deanes, Supervisor of Clay County Supervisor District Four, shall make an inspection of the condition of the portion(s) of the road(s) covered by this Agreement.

At the completion of use of the road(s) or at such time during said use the condition of the road(s) deteriorate to a point of being dangerous or inconvenient to the traveling public, Contractor shall be liable to pay the entire cost of repairs necessary to return the road to the condition it was in prior to the initiation of use. The amount of repairs necessary and the method of accomplishing the same shall be within the reasonable discretion of the Board of Supervisors of Clay County, Mississippi.

Contractor shall at all times utilize the designated portion(s) of road(s) only in a manner which permits unobstructed and safe passage for other members of the traveling public. Contractor hereby covenants to make immediate repair of any conditions on the roadway it causes during use under this permit, which would restrict use of the road by the traveling public, or cause or contribute to a safety condition. Contractor shall not use the road or right of way for a log landing or other loading area.


Contractor shall and does hereby indemnify and save harmless Clay County, Mississippi, and all its officers, agents, and employees, from all suits, actions or claims of any character, name or description brought forth or on account of any injuries received or sustained by any person, persons or property during the performance of Contractor's work and prior to the road being repaired.

This Agreement shall become effective upon signing hereof, and shall continue for a period of sixty (60) days, as long as Contractor complies with the terms hereof, or until otherwise terminated in the sole discretion of the Clay County Supervisor District Four due to significant unrepaired damage to the roadway(s) in question, without liability of Clay County, Mississippi, or Clay County Supervisor District Four for any early cancellation.


Shelton Deanes, Supervisor of Supervisor District Four, reserves the right to cease hauling during periods of inclement weather for the sole purpose of protecting and/or preserving the road bed.

Contractor shall pay a fee of \$100.00, to be collected by the Clay County Chancery Clerk or the Clay County Purchasing Clerk to cover the administrative cost of administering this agreement, and provide a bond in the amount of \$2,000.00, which shall be held as a guarantee to pay for any necessary repairs. **THE EXISTENCE OR USE OF THE BOND SHALL NOT RELIEVE CONTRACTOR OF ANY RESPONSIBILITY TO PAY FOR DAMAGES DETERMINED TO BE IN EXCESS OF THE BOND.** This Agreement and rights hereunder shall be contingent upon payment of said bond and the administrative costs stated herein.
