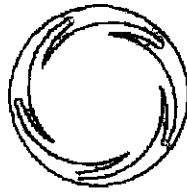

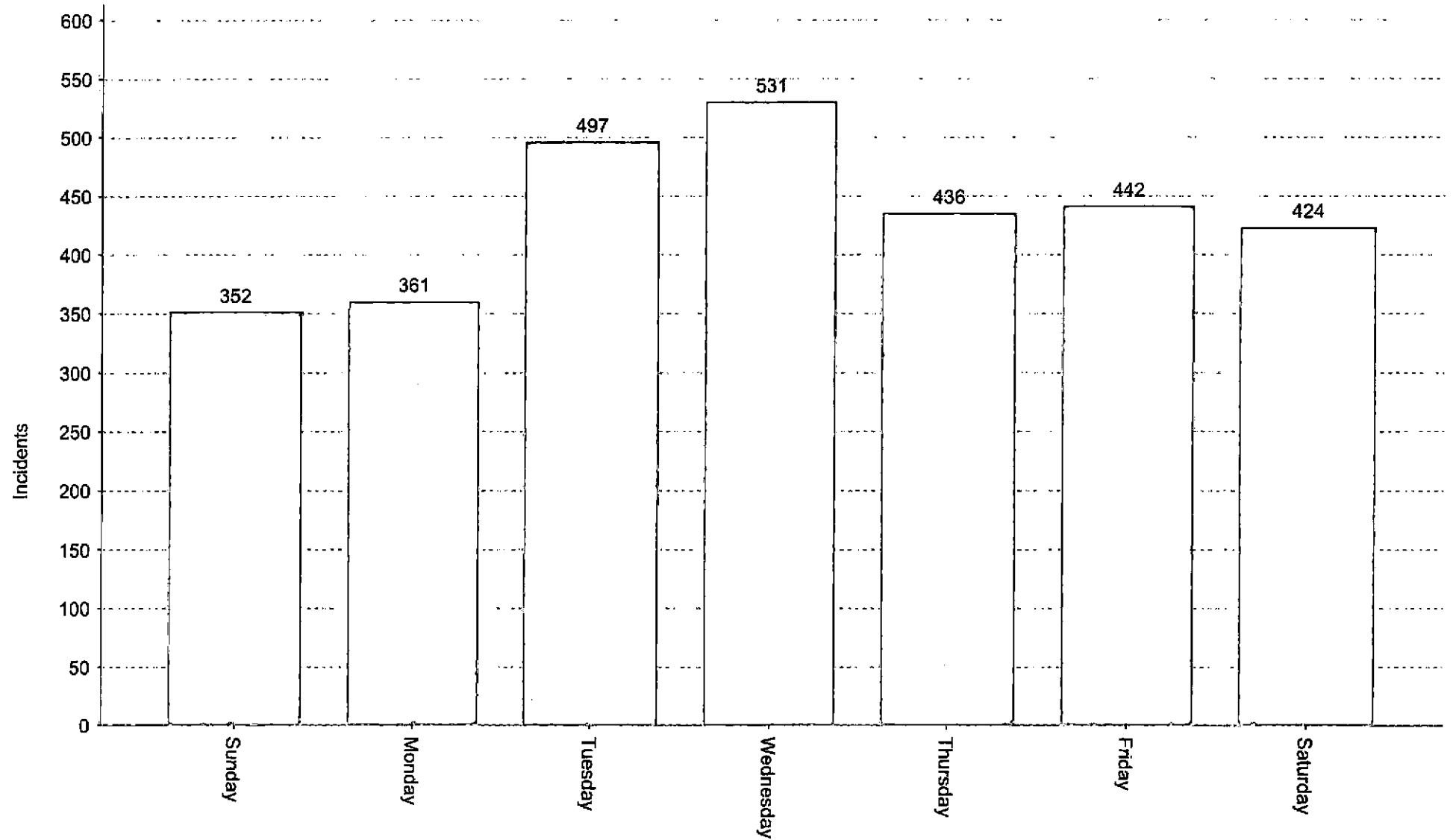




# CAD Statistics - Graph by Day of Week

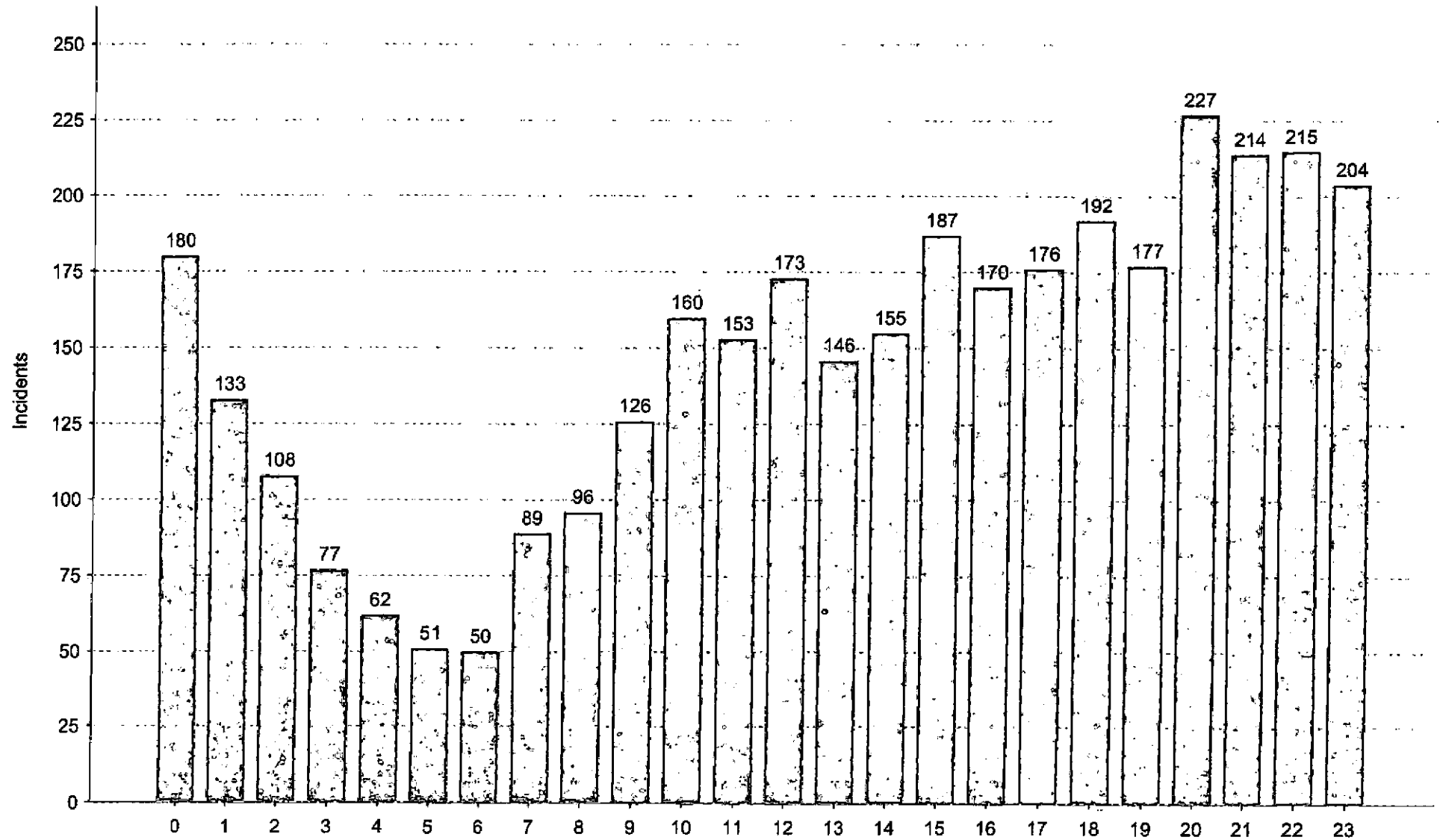
