#### STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID COMPACT

#### (SMAC)

#### Revised December 2009

#### THIS AGREEMENT IS ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AND BY AND AMONG EACH COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY THAT EXECUTES AND ADOPT'S THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED HEREIN, BASED ON THE FOLLOWING FACTS

WHEREAS the State of Mississippi is geographically vulnerable to hurricanes, tornadoes, freshwater flooding and other natural disasters that in the past have caused severe disruption of essential human services and severe property damage to public roads, utilities buildings parks and other government owned facilities, and

WHEREAS Section 33-15-19(a) Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, authorizes the state and its political subdivisions to develop and enter into mutual aid agreements for reciprocal emergency aid and assistance in case of emergencies too extensive to be dealt with unassisted, and

WHEREAS Section 33-15-1 et seq of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended the Mississippi Emergency Act of 1995 (the Act) sets forth details concerning powers duties rights privileges and immunities of political subdivisions of the state rendering outside aid, and

WHEREAS the Act authorizes the State to enter into a contract on behalf of the state for the lease or loan to any political subdivision of the state any real or personal property of the state government or the temporary transfer or employment of personnel of the state government to or by any political subdivision of the state, and

WHEREAS, Section 33-15-17 of the Act authorizes the governing body of each political subdivision of the state to enter into such contract or lease within the state accept any such loan or employ such personnel and such political subdivision may equip maintain utilize, and operate any such property and employ necessary personnel therefor in accordance with the purposes for which such contract is executed and to otherwise do all things and perform any and all acts which it may deem necessary to effectuate the purpose for which contract was entered into, and

WHEREAS the Act requires that each municipality must coordinate requests for state or federal emergency response assistance with its county, and

WHEREAS, the Parties to this Agreement recognize that additional manpower and equipment may be needed to mitigate further damage and restore vital services to the citizens of the affected community should such disasters occur, and

WHEREAS to provide the most effective mutual aid possible, each Participating Government, intends to foster communications between the personnel of the other Participating Governments by visits,

compilation of asset inventories (shown as Exhibit B) exchange of information and development of plans and procedures to implement this Agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to agree as follows

#### SECTION 1 DEFINITIONS

A "AGREEMENT" means the Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement Compact Political subdivisions of the State of Mississippi may become a party to this Agreement by executing a copy of this Agreement and providing a copy with the original signatures and authorizing resolution(s) to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency. Copies of the agreement with original signatures and copies of authorizing resolutions and insurance letters shall be filed and maintained at the Agency headquarters in Pearl Mississippi

**B "REQUESTING PARTY"** means the participating government entity requesting aid in the event of an emergency – Each municipality must coordinate requests for state or federal energency response oscille duece<sup>1</sup> its county

C "ASSISTING PARTY" means the participating government entity furnishing equipment, services and/or manpower to the requesting Party

**D** "AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE" means an employee of a participating government authorized in writing by that government to request offer or provide assistance under the terms of this Agreement. The list of authorized representatives for the participating government executing this Agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A and shall be updated as needed by each participating government.

E AGENCY" means The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency

**F** "**EMERGENCY**" means any occurrence or threat thereof whether natural or caused by man in whi or in peace which results or may result in substantial injury or harm to the population or substantial damage to or loss of property

**G DISASTER**'' means any natural technological or civil emergency that causes damage of sufficient severity and magnitude to result in a proclamation of a Local emergency by a city county in declaration of a State of Emergency by the Governor or a disaster declaration by the President of the United States

H "MAJOR DISASTER" means a disaster that will likely exceed local capabilities and require a broad range of state and federal assistance

**1 "PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENT"** means the State of Mississippi and any political subdivision of the State of Mississippi which executes this mutual aid agreement and supplies a completed executed copy to the Agency

J "PERIOD OF ASSISTANCE" means the period of time beginning with the departure of any personnel and equipment of the Assisting Party from any point for the purpose of traveling to the Requesting Party in order to provide assistance and ending upon the return of all personnel and equipment of the Assisting Party, after providing the assistance requested, to their residence or regular place of work whichever occurs first The period of assistance shall not include any portion of the trip

to the Requesting Party or the return trip from the Requesting Party during which the personnel of the Assisting Party are engaged in a course of conduct not reasonably necessary for their safe arrival at or return from the Requesting Party

K "WORK OR WORK-RELATED PERIOD" means any period of time in which either the personnel or equipment of the Assisting Party are being used by the Requesting Party to provide assistance and for which the requesting Party will reimburse the Assisting Party Specifically included within such period of time are rest breaks when the personnel of the Assisting Party will return to active work within a reasonable time. Specifically excluded from such period of time are breakfast lunch and dinner breaks

Nothing should be derived from the above statement that excludes Assisting Party personnel from being considered 'on the job" for purposes of workers compensation injuries or accidents during these periods

### SECTION 2 PROCEDURES

When a priticipating govern entred to be the tree theoret to sender intriment the entred disaster, it may request emergency related mutual aid assistance either by (I) proclaiming a local emergency and transmitting a copy of that proclamation along with a completed Part I Identification of Need (Form REQ-A Appendix A) to the Assisting Party or to the Agency, or (ii) by orally communicating a request for mutual aid assistance to Assisting Party or to the Agency, followed as soon as practicable by written confirmation of said request shown as Form REQ-A in Appendix A

Mutual aid shall not be requested by Participating Governments unless resou ces available within the stricken area are deemed inadequate by that participating government. Municipalities shall coor limite requests for state or federal assistance with their county Emergency Management Agencies. All requests for mutual aid shall be transmitted by the <u>Authorized Representative</u> or the <u>Director of the Local Emergency Management Agency</u>. Request for assistance may be communicated either to the Agency or directly to an Assisting Party. Requests for assistance under this Agreement shall be limited to major disasters except where the Participating Government has no other mutual aid agreement bised upon Section 33-15-19(a). Mississippi Code in which case a participating Government may request assistance pursuant to the provisions of this agreement.

A REQUESTS DIRECTLY TO ASSISTING PARTY The Requesting Party may directly contact the authorized representative of the Assisting Party and shall provide them with the information in paragraph C below All communications shall be conducted directly between the Requesting and Assisting Parties Each party shall be responsible for keeping the Agency advised of the status of the response activities The Agency shall not be responsible for costs associated with such direct requests for assistance unless it so elects However the Agency may provide by rule, for reimbursement of eligible expenses from the Disaster Assistance Trust fund

#### B REQUESTS ROUTED THROUGH, OR ORIGINATING FROM, THE AGENCY

The Requesting Party may directly contact the Agency in which case it shall provide the Agency with the information in paragraph C below The Agency may then contact other Participating Governments on behalf of the Requesting Party and coordinate the provision of mutual aid The Agency shall not be responsible for costs associated with such indirect requests for assistance unless the Agency so indicates in writing at the time it transmits the request to the Assisting Party In no event shall the Agency be responsible for costs associated with assistance in the absence of appropriated funds In all cases, the

party receiving the mutual aid shall be primarily responsible for the costs incurred by any Assisting Party providing assistance pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement

**C REQUIRED INFORMATION** Each request for assistance shall be accompanied by the following information to the extent known

- 1 A general description of the damage sustained
- 2 Identification of the emergency service function for which assistance is needed (e g fire, law enforcement, emergency medical, transportation communications, public works and engineering, building inspection, planning and information assistance, mass care resource support health and other medical services, search and rescue, etc.) and the particular type of assistance needed
- 3 Identification of the public infrastructure system for which assistance is needed (i.e. sanitary sewer potable water, streets, or storm water systems) and the type of work assistance needed

- 4 The amount and type of personnel, equipment, materials, and supplies needed and a reasonable estimate of the length of time they will be needed and include a description of v orking cord tions and if personnel will be locall housed.
- 5 The need for sites, structures or buildings outside the Requesting Party's political subdivision to serve as relief centers or staging areas for incoming emergency goods and services
- 6 An estimated time and a specific place for a representative of the requesting Party to meet the personnel and equipment of any Assisting party

This information may be provided on the form shown in Appendix A as the form REQ-A, or by any other available means The Agency may revise the format of Form REQ-A subsequent to the execution of this agreement, in which case it shall distribute copies to all participating governments

ASSESSMENT OF AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES AND ABILITY TO RENDER D **ASSISTANCE** When contacted by a Requesting Party or the Agency, the authorized representatives of any participating government agree to assess their government's situation to determine available personnel equipment and other resources All participating governments shall render assistance to the extent personnel equipment and resources are available Each participating government agrees to render assistance in accordance with the terms of this Agreement to the fullest extent possible When the authorized representative determines that his Participating Government has available personnel, equipment or other resources, they shall so notify the requesting Party or the Agency whichever communicated the request, and provide the information on Part II of the REQ-A form The Agency shall, upon response from sufficient participating parties to meet the needs of the requesting Party, notify the authorized representative of the requesting Party and provide them with the information to the extent known on Part 2 of REQ-A form The Assisting Party shall complete a written acknowledgment regarding the assistance to be rendered, setting forth the information transmitted in the request and shall transmit it by the quickest practical means to the Requesting Party or the Agency, as applicable for approval The form to serve as this written acknowledgment is shown in Appendix A as Form REQ-A

**E** WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGEMENT The Requesting Party/Agency shall respond to the written acknowledgment by executing Part 3 of the REQ-A form shown in Appendix A, and returning a copy the Assisting Party by the quickest practical means, maintaining a copy for its file records

F SUPERVISION AND CONTROL The personnel, equipment and resources of any Assisting Party shall remain under operational control of the requesting Party for the area in which they are

serving Direct supervision and control of said personnel, equipment and resources shall remain with the designated supervisory personnel of the Assisting Party Representatives of the Requesting Party shall assign work tasks to the supervisory personnel of the Assisting Party The designated supervisory personnel of the Assisting Party shall have the responsibility and authority for assigning work and establishing work schedules for the personnel of the Assisting Party, based on task or mission assignments provided by the Requesting Party and the Agency The designated supervisory personnel of the Assisting Party shall maintain daily personnel time records material records and a log of equipment hours, be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the equipment and other resources furnished by the Assisting Party, and shall report work progress to the Requesting Party This agreement shall not support any person, group or organization that self deploys

**G** FOOD, HOUSING, SELF-SUFFICIENCY Unless specifically instructed otherwise, the Requesting Party shall have the responsibility of providing food and housing for the personnel of the Assisting Party from the time of their arrival at the designated location to the time of their departure However, Assisting Party personnel and equipment should be, to the greatest extent possible, self-sufficient for operations in areas stricken by emergencies or disasters. The Requesting Party may specify only self-sufficient personnel and equipment in its request for assistance.

**H RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGE** Whenever the employees of the Assisting Party are rendering outside aid pursuant to this Agreement such employees shall have the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities, and shall receive the compensation, incidental to their employment as authorized in 33-15-15(b)(2)

I COMMUNICATIONS Unless specifically instructed otherwise, the Requesting Party shall have the responsibility for coordinating communications between the personnel of the Assisting Party and the Requesting Party Assisting Party personnel should be prepared to furnish communications equipment sufficient to maintain communications among their respective operating units.

#### SECTION 3 REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

The terms and conditions governing reimbursement for any assistance provided under this Agreement shall be in accordance with the following provisions, unless otherwise agreed upon by the Requesting and Assisting Parties and specified in the written acknowledgment executed in accordance with paragraph 2 D and E of this Agreement. The Requesting Party shall be ultimately responsible for reimbursement of all eligible expenses. The Assisting Party shall submit reimbursement documentation to the Requesting Party on the forms shown in Appendix B.

A PERSONNEL During the period of assistance, the Assisting Party shall continue to pay its employees according to its then prevailing ordinances, rules, and regulations The Requesting Party shall reimburse the Assisting Party for all direct and indirect payroll costs and expenses including travel expenses incurred during the period of assistance, including, but not limited to employee pensions and benefits as provided by Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) However, the Requesting Party shall not be responsible for reimbursing any amounts paid or due as benefits to employees of the Assisting Party under the terms of the Mississippi Workers' Compensation Act (Section 71-3-1 Mississippi Code) due to personal injury or death occurring while such employees are engaged in rendering aid under this agreement Both the Requesting Party and the Assisting Party shall be responsible for payment of such benefits only to their own employees

**B** EQUIPMENT The Assisting Party shall be reimbursed by the Requesting Party for the use of its equipment during the period of assistance according to either a pre-established local or state hourly rate or according to the actual replacement, operation, and maintenance expenses incurred For those instances in which costs are reimbursed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the eligible direct costs shall be determined in accordance with 44 CFR 206 228 The Assisting Party shall pav for all repairs to its equipment as determined necessary by its on-site supervisor(s) to maintain such equipment in safe and operational condition. At the request of the Assisting Party fuels miscellaneous supplies and minor repairs may be provided by the Requesting Party, if practical The total equipment charges to the Requesting Party shall be reduced by the total value of the fuels supplies and repairs furnished by the Requesting Party and by the amount of any insurance proceeds received by the Assisting party.

C MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES The Assisting Party shall be reimbursed for all materials and supplies furnished by it and used or damaged during the period of assistance, except for the costs of equipment, fuel and maintenance materials, labor and supplies, which shall be included in the equipment rate established in 3 B. Above unless such damage is caused by gross negligence willful and a ten misconduct intent oral misuse or recklessness of the Acs signature. The Assisting Party's Personnel shall use reasonable care under the circumstances in the operation and control of all materials and supplies used by them during the period of assistance. The measure of reimbursement shall be determined in accordance with 44 CFR 206 228. In the alternative, the Parties may agree that the Requesting Party will replace, with like kind and quality as determined by the Assisting Party, the materials and supplies used or damaged. If such an agreement is made, it shall be reduced to writing and transmitted to the Agency.

**D RECORD KEEPING** The Assisting Party shall maintain records and submit invoices for reimbursement by the Requesting Party or the Agency using format used or required by FEMA publications including 44 CFR part 13 and applicable Office of Management and Budget Circulars Requesting Party and Agency finance personnel shall provide information directions, and assistance for record keeping to Assisting Party personnel

**E PAYMENT** Unless otherwise mutually agreed in the written acknowledgment executed in accordance with paragraph 2 I or a subsequent written addendum to the acknowledgment the reimbursable expenses with an itemized notice as soon as practicable after the expenses are incurred but not later than 60 days following the period of assistance, unless the deadline for identitying damage is extended in accordance with 44 CFR part 206 The Requesting Party shall pay the bill or advise of any disputed items not later than 60 days following the billing date. These time frames may be modified by mutual agreement. This shall not preclude an Assisting Party or Requesting Party from assuming or donating, in whole or in part, the costs associated with any loss, damage, expense or use of personnel, equipment and resources provided to a Requesting Party

**F** PAYMENT BY OR THROUGH THE AGENCY The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may reimburse for all actual and necessary travel and subsistence expenses for personnel providing assistance pursuant to the request of the Agency, to the extent of funds available and contingent upon an annual appropriation from the legislature for such purposes. The Assisting Party shall be responsible for making written request to the Agency for reimbursement of travel and subsistence expenses, prior to submitting a request for payment to the Requesting Party. The Assisting Party's written request should be submitted as soon as possible after expiration of the period of assistance. The Agency shall provide a written response to said requests within 10 days of actual receipt. If the Agency denies said request, the Assisting Party shall then bill the requesting party. In the

event that an affected jurisdiction requests assistance without forwarding said request through the Agency, or an assisting party provides assistance without having been requested by the Agency to do so, the Agency shall not be hable for reimbursement of any of the cost(s) of assistance The Agency may serve as the eligible entity for requesting reimbursement of eligible costs from FEMA Any costs to be so reimbursed by or through the Agency shall be determined in accordance with 44 CFR 206 228 The Agency may authorize applications for reimbursement of eligible costs from the Disaster Assistance Trust Fund established pursuant to Section 33-15-301 Mississippi Code, in the event that the disaster or emergency event is not declared pursuant to the Robert T Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act Public Law 93-288, as amended by Public Law 100-707 Such applications shall be evaluated pursuant to rules established by the Agency, and may be funded only to the extent of available funds

#### SECTION 4 IMMUNITY

To the extent permitted by law, the Parties shall not be hable for actions to the extent provided by Section 33-15-21(a) This immunity may be waived by the Parties in a manner provided by law to the extent that adequate insurance colorage is lefter.

#### SECTION 5 LENGTH OF TIME FOR EMERGENCY

The duration of such Local emergency declared by the Requesting Party is limited to 30 days. It may be extended with review, if necessary, in 30 day increments as specified in 33-15-17(d)

#### SECTION 6 TERM

This Agreement shall be in effect for one (1) year from the date hereof and shall automatically be renewed in successive one (1) year terms unless terminated upon 60 days advance written notice by the participating government. Notice of such termination shall be made in writing and shall be served personally or by registered mail upon the Director, Mississippi Emergency Management Agency. Pearl Mississippi, which shall provide copies to all other Participating Parties. Notice of termination shall not relieve the withdrawing Party from obligations incurred hereunder prior to the effective date of the withdrawal and shall not be effective until 60 days after notice thereof has been set by the Director Mississippi Emergency Management Agency to all other Participating Governments.

#### SECTION 7 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be in full force and effect upon approval by the participating government and upon proper execution hereof

#### SECTION 8 ROLE OF MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

The responsibilities of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency under this Agreement are to (1) request mutual aid on behalf of a participating government, under the circumstances identified in this Agreement, (2) coordinate the provision of mutual aid to a Requesting Party, pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement, (3) serve as the eligible entity for requesting reimbursement of eligible costs from FEMA, upon a Presidential disaster declaration, (4) serve as central depository for executed Agreements, and (5) maintain a current listing of participating Governments with their Authorized Representative and contact information, and to provide a copy of the listing to each of the Participating

Governments on an annual basis during the second quarter of the calendar year MEMA will assume no responsibility for any person, group or organization that self deploys

#### SECTION 9 SEVERABILITY, EFFECT ON OTHER AGREEMENTS

Should any portion section or subsection of this Agreement be held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction that fact shall not affect or invalidate any other portion section or subsection, and the remaining portions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and affect without regard to the section, portion, or subsection or power invalidated

In the event that any parties to this agreement have entered into other mutual aid agreement, pursuant to Section 33-15-19(a) Mississippi Code, or interlocal agreements pursuant to Section 17-13-1 Mississippi Code, those parties agree that said agreements are superseded by this agreement only for emergency management assistance and activities performed in catastrophic emergencies pursuant to this ngreement. In the event that two or more parties to this agreement and the parties wish to engage in the difference of the empty disord tions of this agreement shell  $p_{\rm F}^{-1}$ . To inform the event that two ends of this agreement shell  $p_{\rm F}^{-1}$  is the engage discrete below een those parties.

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

## **CONDITIONS FOR DISBURSEMENT FOR FUNDS**

A Grant Agreement will be executed between the Small Municipality or County and Mississippi Development Authority (MDA). The agreement shall be signed within one month of the grant award date MDA will release Small Municipality and Limited Population County (SMLPC) funds for services rendered, or on a reimbursement basis, for approved eligible costs of the project, as incurred Funds will be released upon receipt of the Small Municipality and Limited Population County Request for Cash and supporting documentation from the Small Municipality or County **Funds may not be disbursed more frequently than once per month.** 

Small Municipalities and Counties have two (2) years from the date of the award to expend the funds under the Small Municipal and Limited Population County Grant Program Failure to implement and complete the project may result in the grant agreement being voided and funds deobligated.

All State Procurement laws should be followed when bidding projects, etc.

Administrative funds will not be paid with SMLPC grant funds.

Effective 7/31/08, per CSD Instruction #08-011 all funds will flow through the local unit of government we will no longer pay vendors, being the contract is between MDA and the municipality or county. All municipalities and counties will be responsible for paying vendors upon receipt of payment.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

**Contingency Cost** In most cases, the budget should include contingency allowance to cover the incidence of unexpected project cost (**Note: these costs do not include engineering/architectural fees**). An allocation of 10% of engineering/architectural fees will be allowed, but cannot exceed this amount

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This Grant Agreement, dated as of the date set forth in Item 1 of Exhibit A (this "Agreement"), by and between the Mississippi Development Authority (acting for and on behalf of the State of Mississippi ("MDA") and the entity set forth in Item 2 of Exhibit A (the "Local Entity").

#### WITNESSETH.

WHEREAS, the Advantage Mississippi Initiative Act, Section 57-1-18, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), was enacted for the purpose of promoting business and economic development in the State of Mississippi (the "State") by providing grants to small municipalities and limited population counties, as defined in the Act, to assist in promoting economic development, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 57-1-18 of the Act, MDA is authorized to make grants to small municipalities or limited population counties for projects to include highways, streets and other roadways, bridges, sidewalks, utilities, airfields, airports, acquisition of equipment, acquisition of real property, development of real property, improvements to real property, and any other project approved by the MDA, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and guidelines adopted by MDA under the Act (the "Guidelines"), the Local Entity has filed an application (the "Application") with MDA for a grant to be used for the development of the Project, more particularly described in Item 3 of Exhibit A (the "Project"), and

WHEREAS, based upon the Application and other relevant factors, MDA has agreed to provide the Local Entity with a grant under the Act in the amount set forth in Item 4 of Exhibit A (the "Grant") under the terms and conditions set forth in Item 5 of Exhibit A, in order to fund, in part, and develop the Project by the Local Entity, and

WHEREAS, the Project is authorized by the Act, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto agree that it is necessary to provide for and demonstrate compliance with the provisions of the Act,

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to assure that the public purpose of the Act is satisfied in order not to be in contravention of those provisions of the Mississippi Constitution prohibiting the State from making donations or granting gratuities by establishing that the Project is an investment resulting in a measurable increase in the infrastructure of the local entity, and

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the parties hereto intend to be legally bound hereby and in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained do hereby agree as follows



Section 1 Grant MDA hereby agrees to make to the Local Entity and the Local Entity hereby agrees to accept from MDA a Grant pursuant and subject to the terms of this Agreement and the Act as set forth in Item 5 of Exhibit A The Local Entity hereby agrees that it will apply the proceeds of the Grant only to the costs of the Project as more fully described in the Application The Grant shall be disbursed by MDA to the Local Entity in installments as provided in this Agreement pursuant to Item 5 of Exhibit A MDA's obligation to make the Grant and to disburse the Grant in installments shall be subject to all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement and the Local Entity satisfying its entire obligation under this Agreement and the Act.

Section 2. Disbursements. The obligation of MDA to make any disbursement of the Grant shall be subject to the following conditions, as well as any others herein set forth

- a. The Local Entity shall not be in default under this Agreement or the Act,
- b The Project shall have progressed at a rate and in a manner reasonably satisfactory to MDA, and
- Receipt by MDA of a certificate of a representative of the Local Entity in С the form set forth in paragraph 3 hereof and the notice required of the Local Entity set forth in paragraph 4 hereof for such disbursement in a form satisfactory to MDA If the Local Entity fails at any time to meet the conditions precedent to any disbursement of the Grant as specified in the preceding sentence, the obligation of MDA to make further disbursements in connection with the grant shall cease until such time and such condition precedent is met and satisfied. The parties hereto agree that disbursements by MDA to the Local Entity of the Grant may be made from time to time or at one time over a one (1) year period The disbursements shall be made in accordance with Item 5 of Exhibit A All rights of the Local Entity to request disbursement of any portion of the Grant not disbursed prior to the anniversary date of the Grant Agreement, shall be forfeited to the State and may be applied by the State in any manner consistent with the terms of the resolution of the State directing the issuance and prescribing the form and details of the Bonds

Section 3 Conditions A condition precedent to all disbursements of the Grant shall be the delivery of a certificate of a representative of the Local Entity to the effect that

- a. To the best of his knowledge, the representations and warranties of the Local Entity contained in this Agreement are true and correct as of the date of the disbursements with the same effect as of made on the date of such disbursements,
- b This Agreement has been duly authorized, executed and delivered by the Local Entity and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the Local Entity enforceable in accordance with its terms, except as such enforceability may be limited by bankruptcy,

reorganization, insolvency, moratorium or other laws affecting creditors' rights generally and except to the extent that the enforceability of the rights set forth herein may be limited by the availability of any particular remedies,

- c This Agreement has not been amended or supplemented or modified since the date of its execution and remains in full force and effect as of the date of the disbursement,
- d The authorization, execution and delivery of this Agreement by the Local Entity, and compliance by the Local Entity with the provisions hereof, will not conflict with or constitute a breach or default of the Local Entity's duties hereunder or under any law, administrative regulation, court decree, resolution, charter, bylaw or other agreement to which the Local Entity is subject or by which it is bound, and
- e There is no action, suit, proceeding or investigation at law or in equity before or by any court or governmental agency or body pending or, to the best of his knowledge, after reasonable investigation and due inquiry, threatened against the Local Entity in any way contesting or affecting the validity of this Agreement or contesting the powers of the Local Entity to enter into or perform its obligations under this Agreement

Section 4 Requisitions A condition precedent to all disbursements of the Grant shall be the presentation to the State Treasurer of a warrant issued by the Department of Finance and Administration of the State or its successor to such duties, which warrant shall be issued under proper requisition signed by the Executive Director of MDA, all pursuant to Miss Code Ann Section 57-1-18(2) and Chapter 451, S B 2126, 2001 Regular Session. Warrants may only be issued for costs and expenses, which are authorized by the Act The Executive Director of MDA shall execute no requisition until the following shall have been satisfied

a The Local Entity shall have provided MDA with reasonable written notice of the amount of the Grant disbursement requested by the Local Entity Such notice shall contain all information necessary to enable MDA to prepare the requisition for a warrant described in this paragraph 4 including, without limitation, the name and title of the requesting representative of the Local Entity, the name of the vendor to be paid or the party to be reimbursed for its previous payment of the work performed and a description of the work performed In addition, such notice shall certify that the amount requested is the just amount due at the current time, is currently unpaid, is for a product or service which has heretofore been delivered or performed and that all statutory requirements in connection with the acquisition of such product or service have been complied with by the Local Entity

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b MDA shall have indicated in writing its approval of the request for the Grant disbursement.

Section 5 Representations of MDA MDA makes the following representations as the basis for the undertakings on the part of the Local Entity herein contained

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- a. MDA is an agency of the State and is authorized pursuant to the provisions of the Act and the Guidelines to enter into the transactions contemplated by this Agreement
- b MDA has full power and authority to enter into the transactions contemplated by this Agreement and to carry out its obligations hereunder
- c MDA has been duly authorized to execute and deliver this Agreement and by proper action has duly authorized the execution and delivery hereof and as to MDA, this Agreement is valid and legally binding and enforceable in accordance with its terms except to the extent that the enforceability thereof may be limited

(1)By bankruptcy, reorganization, or other similar laws limiting the enforceability of creditors' rights generally, or

(2)By the availability of any discretionary equitable remedies

d The Grant for projects to include highways, streets and other roadways, bridges, sidewalks, utilities, airfields, airports, acquisition of equipment, acquisition of real property, development of real property, improvements to real property, and any other project approved by the MDA, will further the purposes of this Act, to wit

For the purpose of enhancing the process of local economic development through the improvement of local infrastructure and project development

Section 6 Representations of the Local Entity The Local Entity makes the following representations as a basis for the Grant and the undertakings on the part of MDA, herein contained

a. The Local Entity has all necessary power and authority to enter into and perform its duties under this Agreement and, when executed and delivered by the respective parties hereto, this Agreement will constitute a legal, valid and binding obligation of the Local Entity enforceable in accordance with its terms except to the extent that

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the enforceability of the rights set forth herein may be limited by bankruptcy, reorganization, insolvency, moratorium or other laws affecting creditors' rights generally and except to the extent that the enforceability of the rights set forth herein may be limited by the validity of any particular remedy

- b The execution and delivery of this Agreement and compliance with the provisions hereof will not conflict with, or constitute a breach of or default under, the Local Entity's duties under any law, administrative regulation, court decree, resolution, charter, bylaws or other agreement to which the Local Entity is subject or by which it is bound
- c There is no consent, approval, authorization or other order of, filing with, or certification by, any regulatory authority having jurisdiction over the Local Entity required for the execution, delivery or the consummation by the Local Entity of any of the transactions contemplated by this Agreement and not already obtained
- d There is no action, suit proceeding or investigation at law or in equity before or by any court or governmental agency or body pending or, to the best knowledge of the Local Entity, after reasonable investigation and due inquiry, threatened against the Local Entity in any way contesting or affecting the validity of this Agreement or contesting the powers of the Local Entity to adopt, enter into or perform its obligations under this Agreement or , materially and adversely affecting the properties or condition (financial or otherwise) or existence or powers of the Local Entity
- e The Local Entity will not discriminate against any employee or any applicant for employment because of the race, religion, disability, color, national origin, sex or age
- f The Local Entity shall comply with the terms and provisions of this Agreement and the Act.
- g The Local Entity certifies that all of the material information contained in the Application is true and correct as of the date of the Application and the date of this Agreement. The Local Entity further acknowledges that MDA, in making the Grant, is relying upon the truthfulness and correctness of the material information contained in the Application
- h The Local Entity represents and warrants that it will further the purposes of the Act, to wit



to provide highways, streets and other roadways, bridges, sidewalks, utilities, airfields, airports, acquisition of equipment, acquisition of real property, development of real property, improvements to real property, and any other project approved by the MDA for the purpose of providing infrastructure and project development to enhance local economic development

Section 7 Termination MDA may terminate its obligation to honor any disbursement of the Grant at any time prior to any disbursement of the Grant if any event occurs, which would constitute a default under this Agreement

Section 8 Notice Addresses All notices given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing signed by the party giving the notice and shall be given by

- a. Certified mail, postage prepaid,
- b Prepaid overnight delivery, or
- c Hand delivery

For the purposes of this Agreement, notices shall be sent to the parties at the addresses set forth on Item 6 of Exhibit A hereto or to such other addresses that the parties may designate in writing

#### Section 9 Miscellaneous

- a. This Agreement has been made by MDA (acting for and on behalf of the State), and the Local Entity, and no person other than the foregoing and their successors or assigns shall acquire or have any right under or by virtue of this Agreement.
- b This Agreement shall become effective upon the execution and the acceptance hereof by the parties hereto and shall be valid and enforceable from and after the time of such execution and acceptance
- c If any paragraph or part of a paragraph of this Agreement shall be declared null and void or unenforceable against any of the parties hereto by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other section or part of a paragraph of this Agreement.
- d In the event any agreement contained in this Agreement shall be breached and such breach shall thereafter be waived, such waiver shall be limited to the particular breach so waived and shall not be deemed to waive any other breach hereunder

- e This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of MDA and the Local Entity and shall be binding upon MDA and the Local Entity and their respective successors and assigns
- f This Agreement shall be governed as to its validity, construction and performance by the laws of the State of Mississippi
- g This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which, when so executed and delivered, shall be an original, but such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same agreement






