Ms Patsy Patterson of the Golden Triangle Planning and Development District conducted the public hearing Ms Patterson, Housing Specialist, reported that the State of Mississippi expects to receive approximately \$15 million for the FY2010 HOME Investment Partnership Program, which has been allocated as follows

- 3 Provide participating jurisdictions, on a coordinated basis, with the various forms of federal housing assistance

Ms Patterson reported that the deadline for HOME program applications is September 29, 2010, at 4 00 PM The HOME program rating factors were each explained and afterward the floor was opened for discussions and questions Applications were handed out to potential homeowners
