- 3 The assessed value of all taxable property within the County according to the last completed assessment for taxation is \$135,483,296, the County has outstanding bonded indebtedness subject to the fifteen percent (15 %) debt limit prescribed by Section 19 9 5 Mississippi Code of 1972 as amended in the amount of \$1 487 000 and outstanding bonded and floating indebtedness subject to the twenty percent (20%) debt limit prescribed by Section 19.9.5.
