WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and the guidelines adopted by MDA, the County has filed an application with MDA for a grant to construct and pave a parking lot related to the Clay County Courthouse and

WHEREAS, based on the application, the Act and the guidelines, MDA has agreed to provide a grant to the County for the purposes set forth, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Clay County Mississippi (the "Governing Body" of the "County"), acting for and on behalf of Supervisor District Five of Clay County Mississippi (the "County") hereby finds, determines, adjudicates and declares as follows

- 1 The Governing Body on April 4, 2013, did adopt a resolution directing that General Obligation Road and Bridge Bonds, Series 2013 (the "Bonds"), of the District in the principal amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) be offered for sale on sealed bids to be received up to and until the hour of 11 00 o'clock a m on April 25, 2013
- As directed by the aforesaid resolution, notice of sale (the "Notice of Sale") of the Bonds was duly published in the *Daily Times Leader* a newspaper published in the City of West Point, Mississippi, and having general circulation in the District, and qualified under the provisions of Section 13-3-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, said Notice of Sale having been published on April 12 and 19, 2013, in said newspaper, the first publication having been made at least ten (10) days preceding April 25, 2013, all as shown by the proof of publication of said Notice of Sale filed in the office of the Clerk
- The Governing Body did meet at its meeting place in the Clay County Courthouse in the City of West Point, Mississippi, at 11 00 o'clock a m on April 25, 2013
- At said time and place one (1) sealed proposal for the purchase of the Bonds was received, examined and considered by the Governing Body, said bid having heretofore been presented by and being on file with the Clerk
- The Governing Body found, determined and adjudicated that the bid received did not meet the requirement of the Notice of Sale stating that "each interest rate specified must be an even multiple of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 of 1%) or one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) "and rejected said bid and authorized the negotiation of the sale of the Bonds with Trustmark National Bank, Jackson, Mississippi, as the bidder, at an interest rate not in excess of 2 40% such interest rate being in compliance with the bidding requirements of the Notice of Sale and directed the counsel for the County, acting for and on behalf of the District, to submit the terms of said negotiation to the Governing Body at their next meeting for approval and ratification






