



It is the County's desire to have the Consultant perform aerial imagery and provide digital orthophotos for the entirety of Clay County The detailed scope of work and deliverables to be provided under this contract are described within the RFP, proposal documents and selection process of the twenty MS County consortium entitled NE-MS-2014 All of these RFP/Proposal documents are bound herein as an integral part of this Contract as Exhibits A-1 through A-5 These are listed below in order of priority in the event of any inconsistent or contradictory provisions.

A-2 The Consultant's response to NE-MS-2014 technical and administrative questions dated November 22,2013

A-3 NE-MS-2014 response to bidder's questions dated October 30, 2013

A-4 The Consultant's proposal dated November 12, 2013

A-5 The NE-MS-2014 Request for proposals (RFP) dated October 16, 2013

All required tasks shall be completed in full and all required data and reports shall be delivered by the Consultant to the County no later than November 18, 2014 Digital orthophotos shall be completed by the end of September 2014 with the 30 day period until October 31, 2014 set aside for final QA/QC and project wrap-up All documents, source documents, databases, indexes, digital images, digital data, reports, etc collected and/or used by the Consultant in the development of this project shall be the exclusive property of Clay County, and the Consultant shall not distribute, sell or loan any of these materials to any other party without full disclosure and written consent of the County Board of Supervisors All materials and data used in the Orthophotography and GIS data development and processing will be delivered back to the County at the project completion.  - 2 The County responds in writing, granting to the Consultant approval for an extension to the applicable completion date for a specified time limit based upon the Consultant's request The County shall have the sole authority to accept and grant, or deny, any schedule extension requests by the Consultant within this provision of the contract, and the County shall not be required to justify or defend any denial, however, the Consultant must provide a detailed explanation as to why the County should consider any schedule extension request

C Force Majeure The Consultant shall not be hable for loss or damage due to delay in delivery resulting from any cause beyond Consultant's reasonable control that directly cause a project delay from or due to compliance with any regulations, order, acts, instructions or priority requests of any Federal, State or Municipal Government or any department or agency thereof, civil or military authority, acts of God, acts or omissions of the County, fires, floods, unusually severe weather, strikes, blackouts, unforeseen factory shutdowns, embargoes, wars, riots, delays or shortages in transportation, inability to obtain labor, manufacturing facilities or material from Consultant's usual sources. In the event of such delay, the County, upon the written request of the Consultant, shall equitably adjust those contractual provisions as may be affected by such a delay. The County shall have the sole authority to accept and grant, or deny, any schedule extension requests by the Consultant within this provision of the contract, and the County shall not be required to justify or defend any denial, however, the Consultant must provide a detailed explanation as to why the County should consider any schedule extension request

III WARRANTY, LIABILITY, AND STANDARD OF CARE

The Consultant shall perform services for the County in a professional manner, using that degree of care and skill ordinarily exercised by and consistent with the standards of competent Consultants practicing in the same profession or a similar locality as the project The Consultant shall warrant that the delivered products meet or exceed the requirements as defined by the scope and exhibits of this contract. In the event any portion of the products or deliverables fails to comply with this warranty obligation and the Consultant is promptly notified in writing prior to one year after completion of such portion of the services, the Consultant shall promptly re-perform or correct such portion of the services at no additional cost to the County

The warranty provided by the Consultant is based on the product conforming to mutually agreeable acceptance criteria, established by the Consultant and the County defined by the scope and Exhibits of this contract. Regarding review and approval of products and deliverables, all reviews/data inspections are to be performed at the map scale specified for the delivered product. All image quality reviews for purposes of approval are to be performed at not greater than a 2.1 map scale of the specification for the delivered product The Consultant shall not be held responsible for any anomalies or imperfections that may be apparent at higher levels of zoom beyond a review of 1 2 Itimes the designated map scale All alignments, seams, etc. will meet the project specification Accuracy measurements will conform to the standard as specified for the specific delivered product and conform to the mutually agreed acceptance criteria Map accuracy requirement shall be as specified by ASPRS Class I mapping for 1'=100' scale maps developed with a six inch pixel, 1'=200' scale maps developed with a twelve inch pixel, and 1'=50' scale maps developed with a three inch pixel Only clearly defined points shall be used for any map scale accuracy checks This process only applies to unambiguous measurements on clearly defined features Radiometry/Color balancing is often subjective The Consultant only warrants the imagery will meet the radiometry specification agreed to within a representative land cover Pilot area to be mapped as soon as practical after imagery acquisition and before general map production

If the County believes that a delivered product does not meet the project specifications, and has 4 evaluated the product against the acceptance criteria the **County** may submit a request for review A determination should be made of the specific non-compliance by checking the questionable characteristic against the acceptance criteria before submitting a claim against the warranty Submissions should include complete information, including tile name, location within tile, nature of the problem and the relationship to the acceptance criteria A screen shot (jpg or bmp) should be provided, if practical The **Consultant** agrees, repair or replacement will occur within thirty (30) days If the **Consultant** disagrees, the claim will be returned to the **County** with a request for mediation

This warranty is in lieu of all other warranties No other warranty, expressed or implied is made or intended by any proposals submitted pursuant to this Contract

The Consultant will provide to the County a current Certificate of Professional Liability Insurance (E&O errors and omissions policy for the professional services covered by this contract) to cover the tasks and deliverables of this contract, with a policy amount of at least one million dollars This Professional Liability Insurance coverage is provided by the Consultant as a Professional Services Corporation to ensure the faithful and satisfactory performance of this project and is provided as one means to defend and indemnify the County The Consultant shall also provide an Accord type certificate of insurance for all liability and workers compensation coverages, the minimum amounts of which must meet State of Mississippi standards and amounts All referenced policies must remain in full effect for the full duration of the contract period with the E&O policy remaining in continuous effect for at least one full calendar year after the contract completion date The E&O accord certificate shall reference the County as a certificate holder

IV PAYMENT TO CONSULTANT

- A Cash payments of the agreed upon total cost for each task of work will be made by the **County** to the **Consultant** as the work is completed and described herein within Exhibit C
- B The Consultant may secure payment for a percentage or the full amount of monies allocated to tasks under each task by submitting to the County the following
 - 1 All deliverable items or evidence of work-in-progress representing that percentage or the full amount of work for which the **Consultant** is claiming payment, and
 - 2 A dated invoice showing the amount of the claimed payment with a brief description of the work done for each separate amount being claimed Invoices may be submitted monthly based upon work-in-progress and/or deliverables
 - 3 The Consultant shall provide a written project status report to NE-MS-2014 for all twenty Counties of the consortium, such report shall list individually the status of progress for each County Written status reports shall be submitted once every two weeks for the period of January 1st, 2014 through March 31st, 2014 and then monthly thereafter until all Counties within the NE-MS-2014 consortium are 100% finished, delivered and accepted The Consultant shall launch and host a

NE-MS-2014 project website upon which all status reports and other written communications shall be posted and maintained within topic oriented links or folders Secure logins will be provided to those NE-MS-2014 County and Agency representatives designated by the County Assessor

- C The County will make prompt payments to the Consultant following receipt of the items described in Paragraph IV A and B, above, subject to formal acceptance by the County-as complete, satisfactory and meeting all applicable specifications--of all deliverable items, or evidence of work in progress, representing that percentage of the full amount required to substantiate the claimed payment
- D The County shall pay within thirty (30) days all payment claims submitted by the Consultant, meeting all of the above requirements, and not formally disputed by the County The County shall not use the disputation of one payment claim as a reason for disputing or not paying on time any other payment claim
- E The County may impose and charge Liquidated Damages of \$50 per calendar day for each day that the Consultant is late beyond the final completion date of November 18, 2014 Liquidated damages shall be capped at a total of \$10,000 (not to exceed) for this contract As described in previous Sections II A B C, the Consultant may request and the County may approve an extension of the final completion date Any such approved extension will become an automatic extension in regard to initiating liquidated damages. The Liquidated Damages may be charged as actual compensation for losses and do not constitute a penalty or forfeiture Liquidated Damages may be deducted by the County as an offset to invoices from the Consultant

V WORK-IN-PROGRESS INSPECTIONS

The Consultant shall cooperate fully with the County or the County's representatives in making possible work-in-progress inspections as frequently as desired by the County In the event the County or its representatives reasonably find that project work is not being performed in accordance with the applicable specifications, then the County shall promptly notify the Consultant in writing of the unacceptable work, and the Consultant shall take immediate appropriate corrective actions

VI OTHER LEGAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

- A The Consultant shall observe and comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances and regulations during its performance under this Agreement
- B The Consultant shall save harmless the County and its representatives from all suits, actions or claims of any kind brought on account of any injuries or damages sustained by any person or property in consequence of any act of omission or negligence by the Consultant or its employees or agents, or from any claims or amounts due arising or recovered under the State's Worker's Compensation laws Consultant's indemnity and hold harmless obligation undertaken pursuant to this contract, if any, shall specifically exclude that portion of such obligations which could require Consultant to indemnify or hold harmless County, its agents, employees, or County Consultants for their own negligence or willful acts or

omissions

C The County agrees to mitigate its damages, should any damages arise in the course of this Agreement, to every extent possible, and to take such reasonable measures to prevent injury or damages within its jurisdiction as any reasonable prudent individual or entity would take

VII <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>

This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns Neither party shall assign its rights and/or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party The RFP by NE-MS-2014 required respondents to identify their entire Team, including major subcontractors The Consultant identified Digital Aerial Solutions as a major photogrammetry sub-consultant which is herein approved for this contract Any additional sub-contractors that the Consultant chooses to use in the course of the work shall 1) be identified in a written request to the County prior to use on this project by the Consultant Such identification must include a basic qualifications statement as called for in the NE-MS-2014 original RFP with detailed contact information for the requested sub-consultant, and 2) be approved by the County The County shall have the sole authority to accept and grant, or deny, any sub-contractor requests by the Consultant within this provision of the contract, however, the County shall not withhold such permission unreasonably for any written request that is necessary for the Consultant to execute the work within the project schedule or specifications The Consultant must provide a detailed explanation as to why the **County** should consider any sub-consultant and approval must be provided in writing by the County

VIII PRICE ESCALATION

The unit rates contained herein shall remain in effect until June 1st 2015 In the event the **County** should cause the project to be delayed beyond June 1st 2015, then the unit rates contained herein may be adjusted to reflect any increases in the Producer Price Index (PPI) Any services provided to the **County** after June 1st 2015 may reflect the average annual PPI for the calendar year prior to when the services are actually provided In no event may the **Consultant** adjust any unit rates to any greater amount if the performance of work occurs after June 1st 2015 and the reason the work occurred after this date is due to any cause directly created by the **Consultant** Any increase in any unit rates shall not exceed 6% in any calendar year

IX WAIVER, MODIFICATION AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

No waiver, modification or cancellation of any term or condition of this Agreement shall be effective unless made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of each party. Nor shall any waivers be deemed to excuse the performance of any act other than those specifically referred to in said written notice of waiver. If any provisions of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable, but that by limiting such provision it would become valid or enforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited

X NOTICE PROVISION

Any notice or communication pertaining to this Agreement shall be deemed to have been duly given

by the parties hereto if sent to the other by common courier (i e FedEx, UPS) or USPS registered mail with delivery confirmation provided by signature or signed return receipt to the address hereinafter stated, or to such other address as the parties may mutually agree upon

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AGREEMENT FOR FINANCING A PORTION OF AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY AND SURVEY SERVICES BETWEEN THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND THE COUNTIES OF CARROLL, CHICKASAW, CHOCTAW, CLAY, GRENADA, HUMPHREYS, KEMPER, LAFAYETTE, LAUDERDALE, LEE, LOWNDES, MONROE, MONTGOMERY, NESHOBA, NOXUBEE,

LEE, LOWNDES, MONROE, MONTGOMERY, NESHOBA, NOXUBEE, OKTIBBEHA, PONTOTOC, TALLAHATCHIE, WEBSTER, AND WINSTON, IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the Mississippi Transportation Commission, a body corporate of the State of Mississippi (the "Commission"), acting by and through the duly-authorized Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Transportation ('MDOT"), and Carroll, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Clay, Grenada, Humphreys, Kemper, Lafayette, Lauderdale, Lee, Lowndes, Monroe, Montgomery, Neshoba, Noxubee, Oktibbeha, Pontotoc, Tallahatchie, Webster, and Winston Counties in the State of Mississippi (each referred to as "County," and collectively as the "Counties") for the purpose of the Commission providing financial assistance to the Counties and assisting the Counties with a portion of the financing of a planned aerial photography and survey services project, effective as of the date of latest execution below

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the Counties, and will be beneficial to the citizens of the State of Mississippi as a whole, to procure updated aerial photography and survey services of and for each of the Counties for the purposes of planning, mapping, and surveying, and

WHEREAS, the Counties have determined that they would likely be able to procure the services of a firm engaged in providing aerial photography and survey services ("aerial orthophotography services") at a lower cost if they solicited proposals as a group, rather than individually, and

WHEREAS, in order to further this goal, a certain Interlocal Cooperation Agreement, identified as the Northeast Mississippi Aerial Photography Update Initiative 2013-2014 Interlocal Agreement, was entered into among the Counties and approved by the Mississippi Office of the Attorney General on or about July 31, 2013, and

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WHEREAS, the said Interlocal Cooperation Agreement provides that each County is responsible for the final contract and payment agreements with the approved services vendor ("contractor"), and

WHEREAS, the Commission, for its own purposes of planning, mapping, and surveying, wishes to acquire access to and use of all data of the type which will be produced by an aerial mapping project, based on the aerial photography and survey services, planned by the Counties, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of all parties hereto, and in the best interests of the State of Mississippi and its citizens, that the parties cooperate to provide the services herein described

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES AND COVENENANTS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS

I PURPOSE

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding Agreement is to provide for an agreement whereby the Commission will reimburse the Counties for certain portions of the costs of the aerial photography and survey services, up to a certain maximum amount, procured under the Northeast Mississippi Aerial Photography Update Initiative 2013-2014 Interlocal Agreement

III RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTIES

The parties understand that conditions presented herein may be modified by the parties and are subject to specific requirements contained in Mississippi law, Federal law, and/or specific acts of the Mississippi Legislature

a Each County agrees as follows

1 To join in the solicitation for proposals for aerial orthophotography services pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement approved by each County,

2 To concur with the selection of the successful services vendor under applicable rules, regulations, and statutory and case law of the State of Mississippi, and to enter into a contract with that vendor to provide the services and create the product(s) described herein,

3 To provide to MDOT, upon MDOT's request, a copy of the proposed aerial orthophotography services contract prior to execution and a copy of the final executed contract,

4 To pay the services vendor as required by the aerial orthophotography services contract,

5 After expending funds for the services contemplated herein, to provide to the Commission, in a form satisfactory to MDOT, evidence of the amount expended along with a request for a reimbursement amount pursuant to this Agreement,

6 To provide to the Commission, at no cost to the Commission other than those provided for herein, a copy of all data, imagery, and aerial photography and orthophotography information obtained from the selected services vendor, in a form that conforms to and meets all United States Geological Survey (USGS) requirements, which are attached herein and made a part hereof as Attachment A, and

7 To grant, and the Counties do hereby grant, to the Commission a royalty-free, perpetual license to access and use all such data, imagery, and aerial photography and orthophotography information in any form necessary for the Commission's purposes of planning, mapping, and surveying and for other purposes that may become necessary The Counties shall further obtain for the Commission any and all perpetual license(s) for such access and use, at no cost to the Commission, that may be necessary to be obtained from other parties

- b The Commission agrees as follows
 - 1 To have MDOT review the proposals for the aerial orthophotography services in a timely manner, if it elects to do so, and
 - 2 To reimburse each County, within a reasonable time, an amount for the actual expenses incurred in obtaining the aerial orthophotography services, not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000 00), after being presented with a request for reimbursement in a form satisfactory to MDOT, along with proper evidence of the expenditure of funds

IV GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1 No contractor or person employed by any County pursuant to the provisions hereof will be considered a contractor, agent, or employee of the Commission or of MDOT The Commission will not be a party to any agreement entered into between or among one or more of the Counties, with the exception of this Agreement
- 2 Neither the Commission nor MDOT will have any type of contractual relationship, implied or expressed, with the services vendor or contractor who provides the aerial orthophotography services Each County covenants that it will bear total responsibility for any alleged breach of contract or disagreement which may arise from that County's contract with the services vendor or contractor
- 3 The Commission has no funds to contribute toward the expenses of the work being performed under the provisions of this Agreement other than the amounts specifically committed herein

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- 4 The Commission's sole responsibility under this Agreement is to reimburse each County up to a maximum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000 00) for expenses paid to the selected services vendor or contractor The Counties may not charge any of their own administrative costs or other expenses against the funds contributed by the Commission
- 5 All parties hereto are subject to the provisions of the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983 (Miss Code Ann, § 25-61-1, *et seq*, as amended), which may require the release of information procured hereunder under the conditions set out in that statutory scheme
- 6 The Commission shall have full and unlimited access to and use of the data, graphics, photographs, imagery, aerial photography and orthophotography, and any and all other work product procured from the selected services vendor or contractor and under the provisions of this Agreement, at no cost to the Commission other than the costs specifically provided for herein
- 7 All contracts and subcontracts shall include a provision for compliance with Senate Bill 2988 from the 2008 Session of the Mississippi Legislature entitled "The Mississippi Employment Protection Act," as published in the General Laws of 2008 and codified at Section 71-11-3 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and any rules or regulations promulgated by the Commission, the Department of Employment Security, the State Tax Commission, the Secretary of State, or the Department of Human Services in accordance with the Mississippi Administrative Procedures Law (Miss Code Ann § 25-43-1, *et seq*, as amended) regarding compliance with the Act Under this Act, the Counties and every contractor shall register with and participate in a federal work authorization program operated by the Umited States Department of Homeland Security to electronically verify information of newly hired/employees pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, Pub L 99-603, 100 Stat 3359, as amended

V AMENDMENTS AND CANCELLATION

This Agreement may be amended through such written supplemental agreements as are entered into by the parties and will be considered to have been amended by operation of law in the event that some part hereof becomes illegal or improper due to a change in State or Federal law or policy

After the proposals are opened, this Agreement may be cancelled or terminated only upon agreement among all of the parties

VI SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unconstitutional or contrary to the laws of the State of Mississippi or the United States of America, or if some provision hereof proves to be an impediment to obtaining funding from the United States government, such provision may be deemed void and, to the extent that it is reasonably possible to do so, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect

VII RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

This Agreement is binding on the Commission and on each of the Counties jointly and severally No provision of this Agreement is intended, nor should it be construed, to give any right or benefit to any person or entity not a signatory hereto

VIII AUTHORITY

MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972

As Amended

SEC 27-33-37 Duties and powers of the board of supervisors

The board of supervisors shall perform the duties imposed by this article on the members, the president, and the board as a unit, with the powers and authority granted and as necessary for the proper administration of the article, and specifically as set out in this section

(a) At each regular monthly meeting the president of the board shall require of and receive from the clerk of the board all applications for homestead exemption having come into his hands as provided in Section 27-33-35 of this article

(b) As soon as practicable after convening, at each regular monthly meeting, the board, in the light of public records, personal knowledge, information given by the assessor, and any other reliable source of information that may be available, shall examine each application which has been delivered to the clerk by the tax assessor, and pass upon its correctness and the eligibility of the property and of the person, under the law, as fully as may be done before final approval, after the land roll has been finally approved of minute record, and the board shall carefully consider and construe the relationship between buyers and sellers of property on which homestead exemption is sought, and the terms conditions, rate of interest, payments made and to be made, of all conveyances doubtful in such respect "One (1) member of the board shall check each application prior to the time for final approval, and shall indicate if it should be approved, disapproved, or if it requires further investigation

(c) If any application be found incorrect or incomplete in any particular required by law, or deficient in any respect, the board shall give notice immediately to the applicant, in writing, by mail, advising the applicant of the defect and the nature thereof, so that the applicant may correct same, if it can be corrected, before the time for final action by the board

(d) The year in which the land roll is made, at the meeting of the board of supervisors at which the certificate of the commission finally approving the land assessment roll is received and entered in its minutes, and at the September meeting the board of supervisors shall complete the consideration of each and every application for homestead exemption, and all applications, or claims, not clearly within the provisions and requirements of this article shall be disallowed by the board. Where it appears to the board, in a case or cases involving transactions completed after July 1, 1938, that conveyances have been made without bona fide consideration, and liens taken with questionable consideration or values, or where the payments on the principal have not been made as required, or there is evidence of any kind that the transactions were not bona fide in every particular, and were entered into for the purpose of obtaining a homestead exemption contrary to the letter and spirit of law, the application shall be disallowed

(e) Each application shall be plainly endorsed "allowed" or "disallowed" as the case may be, over the date, and the signature of the president of the board, who may use a facsimile stamp for the purposes, and, in the space provided on the application for that purpose, there shall be entered for each assessment, (1) the page and line number of the assessment on the land roll, (2) the total number of acres, (3) the total assessed value of the land, (4) the assessed value of the buildings, (5) the total assessed value of the exempted land and buildings, (6) the assessed value of the land and buildings not exempted, (7) the name of the road district, if any, in which the property lies, and (8) the name of the school district in which the property lies

(f) All applicants, whose applications are finally disallowed by the board, shall be given notice immediately by the board, in writing, by mail Petitions and objections by applicants for correction or amendment shall be heard by the board at the next regular meeting of the board after notice that the application was finally disallowed

(g) It shall not be necessary that an order be entered on the minutes of the board which allows or disallows an application as provided by paragraph (f) hereof, unless there be a division among the board members, then an order shall be entered on the minutes recording the aye and nay vote

(h) The board of supervisors shall have, and is hereby given, the power and authority to summon and examine witnesses under oath, to examine records, and to do any and all other things necessary and proper to ascertain the facts with respect to any application, or claim, for homestead exemption presented to it. The board shall disallow any application for homestead exemption when it is found that the person or the property was ineligible, after the supplemental roll is approved and within one (1) year after that in which the application was executed, and it shall correct, likewise, any and all errors found in the supplemental roll. When an application is disallowed by the board after the supplemental roll has been approved, it shall give notice and proceed as in the case of a rejection by the commission. A certified copy of the order finally disallowing an application, and making a correction in the supplemental roll must be adopted no later than September 30 and shall be received by the commission no later than October 15 of the year following the year in which the supplemental roll was made

(i) At the first regular or special meeting of the board of supervisors held after the supplemental roll, required by Section <u>27-33-35</u> of this article, has been made, it shall examine the said roll, and if found correct shall enter in the minutes an order approving the same, and the applications disallowed shall be listed in the minutes by name and amount, with the reason for disallowance. A copy of said order shall be attached to the supplemental roll and sent to the commission

(j) All applicants whose applications are rejected for reimbursement of tax loss by the commission, after having been allowed by the board, shall be given notice immediately by the board in writing, by mail, with the reasons for the rejection by the commission, and the applicants shall have thirty (30) days in which to file objections thereto, which objections shall be heard by the board at the same or the next regular meeting after objections are filed by the applicant. If the board finds that in its opinion the application should be allowed, it shall continue the matter in its record, and present its objection to the rejection, with evidence in support of same, to the commission. All applications finally rejected by the commission shall be disallowed by the board, and entered of minute record

(k) When the board shall receive notice from the commission that an application for homestead exemption has been rejected by the commission for reimbursement of tax loss, the board shall proceed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (j) hereof. Upon the hearing of objections of the applicant if the board finds that the application should be disallowed, it shall so order and notify the commission that its rejection has been "accepted." If the board is of the opinion that the application should be allowed, it shall notify the commission that it objects to the rejection of the application, and shall submit, in writing its reasons for the "objection." All such matters between the board and the commission may be concluded by correspondence, or by personal appearance of the board, or one or more of its members, the clerk, or the assessor, or by a representative of the commission present at any meeting of the board. The decision of the commission rejecting an application for reimbursement of the tax loss shall be final, and the board shall disallow the application and proceed as hereinafter provided.

(1) When an application for homestead exemption is finally rejected by the commission for reimbursement of tax loss which has been regularly approved by the board and entered on the supplemental roll, or

(1) Where an application has been wrongfully allowed by the board

When any property has been reassessed as herein provided, all additional taxes due as a result of such reassessment shall become due and be payable on or before the first day of February of the year following that in which notice to make the reassessment is issued, and if not paid, the tax collector shall proceed to sell the property for the additional taxes in the same manner and at the same time other property is sold for the current year's taxes, or he may collect the taxes by all methods by which other taxes on real estate may be collected Provided, no penalty or interest shall be applied for any period prior to February 1 of the year following that in which the reassessment is made, and provided further, that such reassessment shall not take effect or become a lien on the property of bona fide purchasers or encumbrancers for value without notice thereof, unless there shall have been filed prior to their attaining such status a notice of rejection in the chancery clerk s office in the county in which the property is located, which notice shall be recorded and indexed as are deeds, but the applicant shall in all cases remain personally liable for such reassessment

(m) The board of supervisors may employ the clerk of the board to collect and assemble data and information and to perform the services required of the board by paragraph (e) of this section and to make investigations required in connection with the duties of the board in determining the eligibility of homestead exemptions and to perform all other ministerial duties required of the board in connection with administering the Homestead Exemption Law and as directed by the board If the board employs the clerk, he shall be paid out of the general county fund as follows for the first two thousand (2,000) applications he may, in the discretion of the board, be paid not exceeding One Dollar (\$1 00) each, for the next two thousand (2,000) applications he may be paid not exceeding Sever ty-five Cents (75cents) each, for the next two thousand (2,000) applications he may be paid not exceeding Fifty Cents (50cents) each, for the next two thousand (2,000) applications he may be paid not exceeding Thirty-five Cents (35cents) each, all over the above number he shall be paid not exceeding Twenty-five Cents (25cents) each The board shall require the assessor to correctly describe all lands included in any applications for homestead exemption, and to assess all such lands on the land assessment roll, separately from other lands, as required by this article, and to present to the board all proper and necessary notices for the correction of land descriptions on the roll, changes in ownership, and for increases and decreases in the assessments of exempt homes
