- 1 Each of the parties owns and maintains equipment for the suppression of fires and for the supplying of emergency medical services. Each of the parties also retains firefighting personnel who are trained to provide various levels of emergency medical services.
- 2 In the event of a major fire disaster, or other emergency, each of the parties will need the assistance of the other party to provide supplemental fire suppression and emergency medical service equipment and personnel
- 3 Each of the parties has the necessary equipment and personnel to enable it to provide such service to the other party in the event of such an emergency
- 4 The geographical boundaries of each party are located in such a manner as to enable each party to render mutual and service to the other

The parties, to carry out the purposes and functions described above and in consideration of the benefits to be received by each of the parties, agree as follows

- Request for Assistance The commanding officer of the fire department or the officer in charge of a fire unit or an emergency medical service unit at the scene of an emergency, or either party, is authorized to request assistance from the other party if confronted with an emergency situation at which the requesting party has need for equipment or personnel in excess of that available at the requesting party's fire department {In the event of a structure fire in the territory of Lowndes Co District #5, Lowndes County will dispatch Tibbee Volunteer Fire Department first followed by District #5 Volunteer Fire Department }
- 2 <u>Response to Request.</u> Upon dispatch of Tibbee Volunteer Fire Department as automatic aid to District 5 Volunteer Fire Department the commanding officer of the party receiving the request shall immed ately take the following action
 - A Determine if the responding party has equipment and personnel available to respond to the requesting party and determine the nature of the equipment and number of personnel available
 - B Determine what available equipment and what available personnel should be dispatched in accordance with the operating plans and procedures established by the parties
 - C In the event the needed equipment and personnel are available, to dispatch such equipment and personnel to the scene of the emergency with proper operating instructions
 - D In the event the needed equipment and personnel are not available, to immediately advise the requesting party of such fact
- 3 <u>Command Responsibility at Emergency Scene</u> The chief officer or senior officer of the party to which the response is made shall be in command of the operations under which the equipment and personnel sent by the responding party shall serve, provided, that the responding equipment

and personnel shall be under the immediate supervision of the officer in charge of the responding apparatus

- 4 <u>Termination of Service</u> The equipment and personnel of the responding party shall be released from service and returned to the responding district by the commanding officer in charge of the operations as soon as conditions may warrant





ARTICLE 1

The purpose of this agreement is to cooperate in a wildlife damage management project, as described in the Work Plan on the next page

ARTICLE 2

APHIS WS has statutory authority under the Act of March 2 1931 (46 Stat 1468, 7 U S C 426 426b) as amended and the Act of December 22 1987 (101Stat 1329-331 7 U S C 426c) to cooperate with States, local jurisdictions, individuals public and private agencies organizations and institutions while conducting a program of wildlife services involving mammal and bird species that are reservoirs for zoonotic diseases or animal species that are injurious and/or a nuisance to, among other things agriculture horticulture forestry animal husbandry wildlife and human health and safety

ARTICLE 3

APHIS WS and the CLAY COUNTY agree

- 1 APHIS WS will provide the requested wildlife damage management services
- 2 The CLAY COUNTY will provide the U.S. Department of Agriculture the sum of \$7,500 00 to cover the costs as outlined in the Financial Plan Payment will be made by check payable to "U.S. Department of Agriculture" by a mutually agreed upon date
- 3 The Clay County ensures and certifies that it is not currently debarred or suspended and is free of delinquent Federal debt

- 7 The performance of wildlife damage management actions by APHIS WS under this agreement is contingent upon a determination by APHIS WS that such actions are in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act Endangered Species Act and any other applicable federal statutes. APHIS WS will not make a final decision to conduct requested wildlife damage management actions until it has made the determination of such compliance.

ARTICLE 4

Pursuant to Section 22 Title 41 United States Code no member of or delegate to Congress shall be admitted to any share or part of this Agreement or to any benefit to arise therefrom

ARTICLE 5

APHIS assumes no liability for any actions or activities conducted under this Cooperative Service Agreement except to the extent that recourse or remedies are provided by Congress under the Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) (28 U S C 1346(b) 2401(b) and 2671 2680)

ARTICLE 6

The Agreement shall become effective October 1, 2015 and shall continue in effect until the completion or termination of the project. This Agreement may be amended or terminated at any time by mutual agreement of the parties in writing. Further, in the event the Clay County does not provide necessary funds. APHIS WS is relieved of the obligation to provide services under this agreement.



This agreement is entered into under the authority of the City of West Point, Mississippi, acting by and through its Mayor and Board of Selectmen and Clay County, Mississippi, acting by and through the Clay County Board of Supervisors

- 1 Each of the parties owns and maintains equipment for the suppression of fires and for the supplying of emergency medical services Each of the parties also retains firefighting personnel who are trained to provide various levels of emergency medical services
- 2 In the event of a major fire, disaster, or other emergency, each of the parties will need the assistance of the other party to provide supplemental fire suppression and emergency medical service equipment and personnel
- 3 Each of the parties has the necessary equipment and personnel to enable it to provide such service to the other party in the event of such an emergency
- 4 The geographical boundaries of each party are located in such a manner as to enable each party to render mutual aid service to the other

The parties, to carry out the purposes and functions described above and in consideration of the benefits to be received by each of the parties, agree as follows

- Request for Assistance The commanding officer of the fire department or the officer in charge of a fire unit or an emergency medical service unit at the scene of an emergency, or either party, is authorized to request assistance from the other party if confronted with an emergency situation at which the requesting party has need for equipment or personnel in excess of that available at the requesting party's fire department
 - A Assistance will be automatically rendered in cases where there is threat of life, entrapment, or technical rescue required beyond County capabilities, including but not limited to
 - (1) Structure fires within a 5 mile radius of city limits, (11) Motor vehicle accidents requiring extrication, and (111) Hazardous materials spills and incidents
- 2 Response to Request Upon receipt of such a request, the commanding officer of the party receiving the request shall immediately take the following action
 - A Determine if the responding party has equipment and personnel available to respond to the requesting party and determine the nature of the equipment and number of personnel available
 - B Determine what available equipment and what available personnel should be dispatched in accordance with the operating plans and procedures established by the parties
 - C In the event the needed equipment and personnel are available, to dispatch such equipment and personnel to the scene of the emergency with proper operating instructions
 - D In the event the needed equipment and personnel are not available, to immediately advise the requesting party of such fact

- 3 <u>Command Responsibility at Emergency Scene</u> The chief officer or semior officer of the party to which the response is made shall be in command of the operations under which the equipment and personnel sent by the responding party shall serve, provided, that the responding equipment and personnel shall be under the immediate supervision of the officer in charge of the responding apparatus
- 4 <u>Termination of Service</u> The equipment and personnel of the responding party shall be released from service and returned to the responding district by the commanding officer in charge of the operations as soon as conditions may warrant
- 5 <u>Liability</u> Each party agrees to assume responsibility for all liabilities that occur or arise in any way out of the performance of this agreement by its personnel only and to save and hold the other party, its employees and officials, harmless from all costs, expenses, losses and damages, including cost of defense, incurred as a result of any acts or omissions of the party's employees relating to the performance of this agreement
- 6 <u>Insurance</u> Each party agrees to maintain adequate insurance coverage for its own equipment and personnel
- Compensation Each party agrees that it will not seek compensation for services rendered under this agreement from the other party in charge of a fire unit or an emergency medical service unit at the scene of an emergency, or either party, is authorized to request assistance from the other party if confronted with an emergency situation at which the requesting party has need for equipment or personnel in excess of that available at the requesting party's fire department
- 8 <u>Pre-Emergency Planning</u> The commanding officers of the parties shall, from time to time, mutually establish pre-emergency plans which shall indicate the types of and locations of potential problem areas where emergency assistance may be needed, the type of equipment that should be dispatched under various possible circumstances, and the number of personnel that should be dispatched under such circumstances. Such plans shall take into consideration and insure the proper protection by the responding party of its own geographical area
- 9 <u>Non-Exclusive Agreement</u> The parties to this agreement shall not be precluded from entering into similar agreements or first response agreements with other municipal corporations
- 10 <u>Termination</u> This agreement may be terminated by either party giving to the other party a thirty (30) day notice of termination in writing
