

## CHUQUATONCHEE CONSOLIDATED DRAINAGE DISTRICT CLAY AND CHICKASAW COUNTY

### Background

District formed in 1958 July 1962 – watershed work plan approved October 1963 – Contract signed with Department of Agriculture – Soil Conservation 1968-1989 – 14 flood structures completed 1970 – Drainage tax imposed on benefited acres March 1993 – District notified by Corp of Engineers of deauthorization of project Reasons for termination of project by government Unable to acquire 401 Water Quality Certificate and engineering problems with

channelization

### **Drainage Tax**

Beginning in 1970 a drainage tax was placed on benefited acres of the District. The tax was discontinued in 1997. Purpose of the drainage tax was to fund repayment of a loan from Farmers Home. Administration and for maintenance of the channel.

The drainage was paid by benefited landowners in Chickasaw and Clay Counties.

Benefits in Chickesaw County77 48%Benefits in Clay County22.52%

### Settlement with U\_S\_Government

From 1993 to 2001 a series of meetings was held with the Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation/Natural Resources and Corp of Engineers to settle and resolve the matter Meetings were held locally on the State level and in Washington D C

In early 2001 the United States Government offered \$13,000,000 00 as settlement to the District The Board accepted the offer with approval of the Court

### Settlement Distribution to Landowners

Distribution to landowners or heirs began in December 2001. First, all drainage taxes were refunded to the landowners or heirs with interest at the State legal rate of interest. These taxes were collected from 1970 to 1997

Next, damages were paid to all landowners or heirs for the years 1970 to settlement.

All calculations were based on benefited acres as previously determined by Soil Conservation

All funds were distributed except \$27,767 49 for landowners or heirs who could not be located. These funds were turned over to the Mississippi State Treasury Unclaimed Funds Division on July 22, 2015

At the time of the distribution each landowner or heir was required to execute a "Release" and a "Perpetual Easement" on the channel

### Funds on hand

The district has accumulated approximately \$344,000 00 in funds over a period of 45 years. This money was set aside over the years as a reserve fund and has continually earned interest

The Board feels these funds should be transferred to Chickasaw and Clay Counties for continued upkeep of the channel. The amount to each county will be based on the benefited acres in each county Chickasaw 77 48% Clay 22 5/%

The use of the funds should be restricted to clean out of log jams and repairs to the channel and bridges.

## Interlocal Agreement Between Mississippi State University and Clay County, Mississippi

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2016 by and between Mississippi State University, through the Mississippi State University Extension Service ("MSUES"), and Clay County, acting by and through its governing body, the Clay County Board of Supervisors, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY These parties witnesseth

WHEREAS, this Agreement is made under the authority of Sections 17-13-1 et seq, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended,

WHEREAS, MSUES has been advised by the United States Department of Agriculture of the need for this Agreement, and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interest of both parties, and that the undertaking will benefit the public

NOW THEREFORE, MSUES and COUNTY agree as follows.

## SECTION 1 Duration/Amendment

This Agreement shall be in effect for four (4) years from the last date of signature At the expiration of this initial term or any subsequent term, the agreement will be available for review, revision or cancellation by both parties. Otherwise, this agreement will automatically renew for up to three (3) successive four (4) year periods. However, this Agreement may be amended at any time by the mutual consent of MSUES and COUNTY. Any Amendment will require the parties to comply with the provisions of Mississippi Code § 17-13-1 et seq.

## SECTION 2. Purpose

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The purpose of this agreement is to document the relationship between MSUES and COUNTY concerning the management of county Extension agents and staff This includes the hiring process, compensation, fringe benefits, supervision, discipline and termination of the Extension agents and staff

### SECTION 3 Statutory Authority

There will be no separate legal or administrative entity created pursuant to this Agreement MSUES and COUNTY are authorized by Miss Code Section 19-5-63 to exercise and carry out the powers, authorities, and responsibilities to be exercised by each of them pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

## SECTION 4 Financing, Staffing and Supplying

Pursuant to Miss Code Section 19-5-63, the financing and staffing of the county Extension offices shall be provided as follows

- COUNTY shall provide office space for the county Extension department and shall equip the said office with the necessary office equipment and furniture through COUNTY's normal budgetary and procurement procedures COUNTY shall also furnish the necessary record books, maps, and other items incidental to the proper operation of the department Any such equipment or supplies provided shall remain the property of COUNTY
- COUNTY shall share in financing for salary and fringe of county Extension agents and staff as approved by the Board of Supervisors MSUES will submit invoices to COUNTY on a monthly basis for these personnel. All personnel will be on MSU payroll to expedite personnel's access to MSUES systems for Extension Reporting and HR purposes
- COUNTY shall provide telecommunications support for the county Extension offices including internet and telephone service
- MUSES shall provide computing devices for the use of the county Extension staff including computers, printers, and mobile devices in compliance with Mississippi State University policies, as needed for the execution of the duties of the office Said devices will remain on Mississippi State University inventory and the county offices will comply with all Mississippi State University policies and procedures related to property management
- MSUES shall provide funding for the salaries and fringe for the remainder of the expenses not covered through COUNTY funding
- COUNTY may, but has no obligation to, provide additional fringe benefits to MSUES employees hired to work in each COUNTY

## SECTION 5 Extension Office Personnel

Staffing levels for the county Extension office will be determined by MSUES Upon MSUES determining that a position needs to be filled in the county Extension office, MSUES will seek a board order This board order will confirm the amount of funding COUNTY will provide for the position and any COUNTY policies that the employee will be required to comply with MSUES will follow all Mississippi State University policies and procedures for the position and hiring of this position COUNTY Board of Supervisors will have a voting member (to be selected from the current Board members) on the interview committee(s) for each position to be filled

All personnel will be subject to all Mississippi State University policies and procedures including but not limited to hiring, compensation, raises, discipline and termination If COUNTY desires employees to comply with additional policies and procedures, these must be expressly detailed in the board order confirming the funding and will be included in the offer letters issued by MSU provided to the employee at hiring Additionally, if COUNTY desires to provide any additional benefits to the employees, these additional benefits must be included in the offer letters issued by MSU.

All termination decisions will be made in compliance with Mississippi State University policies and procedures Any such decision will be made with guidance from MSU's General Counsel and MSU's Director of Human Resources Management.
