THE OPERATOR INFORMED ME THAT THEY WERE WAITING ON AT&T TO MOVE A PHONE PED BUT AT&T HAD INFORMED HIM IT WOULD BE SEVERAL WEEKS BECAUSE THEY HAD NOT BEEN NOTIFIED OR GIVEN DRAWINGS ABOUT THIS CONSTRUCTION. DURING THE MEAN TIME THE EQUIPMENT OPERATOR PERSUADED A COUPLE OF AT&T GUYS TO HELP HIM MOVE THE PHONE PED

TEMPORARILY SO HE COULD FINISH HIS WORK. THEY MOVED THE PHONE PED LEAVING BIG HOLES AND A PILE OF DIRT ON MY PROPERTY. I HAD TO MOVE THE PILE OF DIRT WITH MY EQUIPMENT IN ORDER TO RE-BUILD MY FENCE. NEEDLESS TO SAY THE COUNTY HAS NOT FOLLOWED UP WITH AT&T AND THE PHONE PED IS STILL IN ~~THE~~ ITS TEMPORARY LOCATION WITH LINES HANGING OUT. SEE PHOTOS #3 & #4.

FINALLY, DURING THE CONSTRUCTION CREWS CLEAN UP ON THE NORTH BRIDGE THEY DAMAGED CORNER POST, T-POST, AND KNOCKED A LOT OF SLACK IN THE FENCE ITSELF. SEE PHOTOS #5 THRU #9.

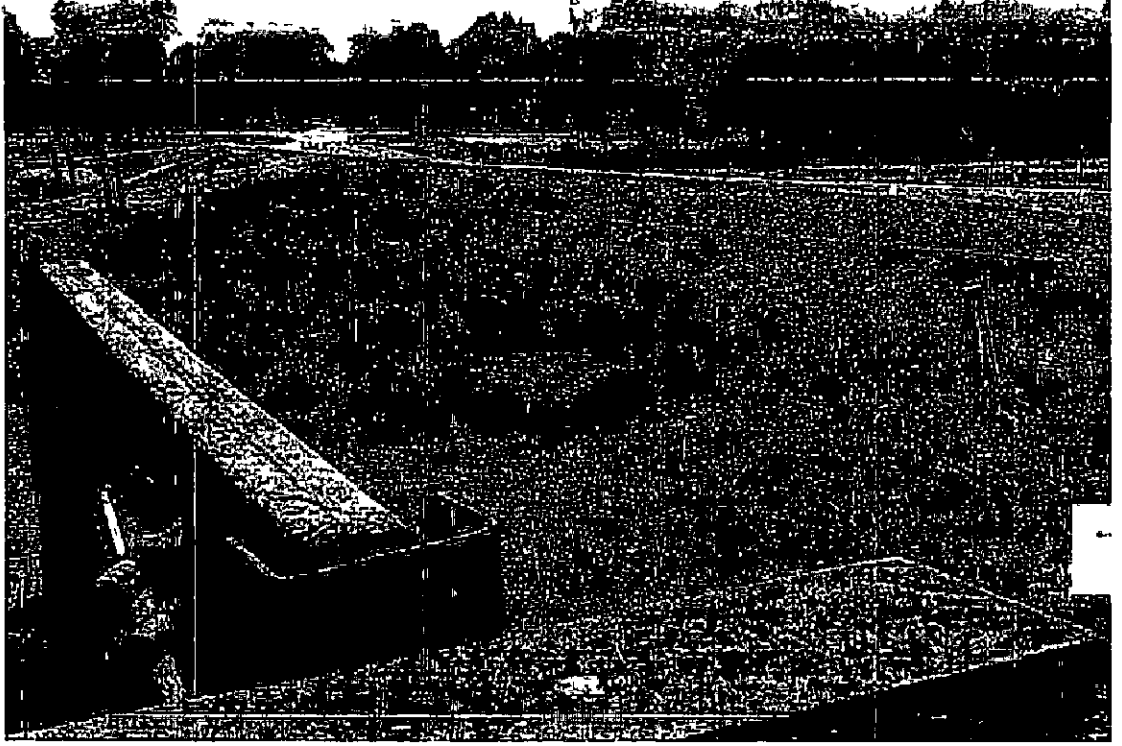
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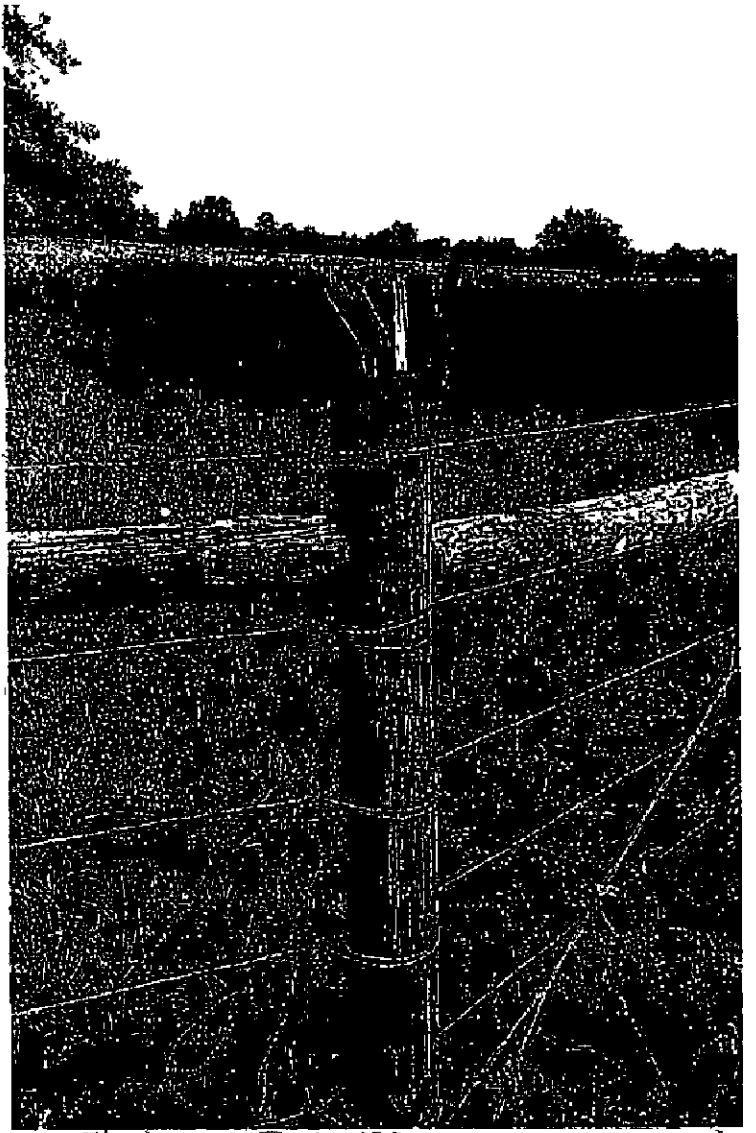
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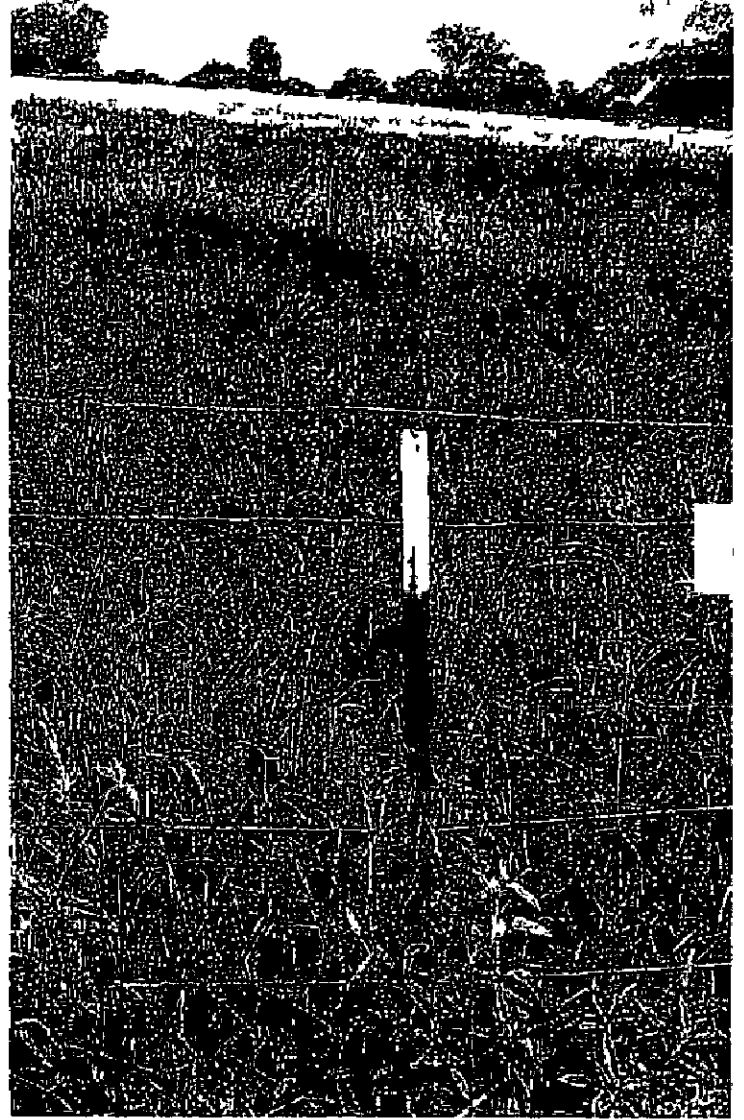
