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

Introduction

Tri-State Consulting is pleased to submit this proposal to Clay County for the digital mapping of the parcel data and creation of additional layers in keeping with the Mississippi Department of Revenue requirements Tri-State has provided these same services to over half of the counties in Mississippi Tri-State s staff has over 100 years of combined experience in the mapping and GIS related fields including an IAAO Certified Mapping Specialist A client list and reference letters are included in this proposal. Staff qualifications are also provided

Clay County procured new orthophotography flown in February 2014 The acquisition of this new photography, necessitates the re-mapping and conversion of the existing ownership maps to a digital/GIS format In addition to the parcel mapping additional datasets will need to be created and incorporated into the geodatabase

Tri-State has a history of assisting rural counties with budgetary constraints by spreading the costs over multiple fiscal years. This cost break down is reflected in the cost summary. Tri-State will work with Clay County and determine a delivery schedule that meets the county's needs

Map Assembly

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Many firms scan the existing maps and then attempt to rubber-sheet or "stretch" these to match the new photography Due to the amount of distortion and scaling issues in the existing maps, this is not a viable approach Tri-State will begin by scanning both the existing ownership map mylars and the subdivision plats (those that can be scanned without harming the originals) Copies of both sets of scanned images will be delivered to the County for reference and backup/archival purposes Section lines and corresponding fractional divisions will be performed utilizing the USGS sectional data as the initial basis Adjustments will be made where warranted Road center lines will be captured using the newly acquired aerials as the base map and rights-of-way offset parallel to produce consistent widths Hydrology (water features) will be captured from the new orthophotos

Property lines will be established by three methods

1 Subdivisions will be mapped from the recorded plats utilizing the COGO process

2 The existing maps will serve as the primary source of information Dimensions will take priority over existing scale Property lines will be adjusted to match the physical and cultural features of the new photography

3 In instances where existing property lines do not match the photo features, the parcel will be re-mapped from vesting instrument descriptions Once all work is completed an edit process is performed by a senior compiler. This process includes both an on screen review and edit prints are created to assist in this review process. The review process ensures parcel lines and right of ways are mapped accurately and annotation is placed cartographically correctly

Map Maintenance

Map maintenance is currently performed by Sanders & Associates Tri-State will incorporate any changes made to the maps during the course of the mapping project Keeping the digital data up to date and in sync with the land roll will make the reconciliation process easier with less orphans to investigate Any changes to the map data must be provided to Tri-State by February 28, 2019 to be incorporated in to the final delivered product

Reconciliation 🐐

A vital step to parcel mapping is the reconciliation process This process allows the county to identify errors or omissions in the land roll file and on the maps Research is required to determine whether parcels should be removed from the land roll or map or added to one or the other 'Once the initial mapping is completed it is possible to perform spatial (visual) queries as part of reconciliation. These steps include

1 Reconcile the parcels in the map against parcels in the land roll. This will show parcels that are on the map not in the land roll and parcels in the land roll not mapped. This typically results in some parcels being deleted from the roll and parcels added to the maps and vice versa.

2 Reconcile tax districts from the land roll records against district lines in the maps The results can show for example all parcels within a city colored as green Any parcels inside the city that are not green or parcels outside the city filled as green identifies problems that need to be corrected

All reports will be presented to the Tax Assessor for review

Soils/Land Use

The Mississippi Department of Revenue requires that all parcels valued on an agricultural use basis be recalculated within two years of acquisition of new aerial photography The steps involved are as follows

1 Tri-State will evaluate the existing land use layer to determine if accurate calculations can be made If the existing data can be used the process of delineation can be skipped, if the data's cannot be used this step will have to take place The provided cost on the cost page, does not cover delineation It only covers the review of the existing data and calculations

2 The digital soil maps available from NRCS will be added to the geodatabase

^{'3} The individual soil types will be grouped according to productivity fatings provided by the Mississippi Department of Revenue

4 Each parcel will then be calculated as to the number of acres of each type of soil and use The acreages will be adjusted to match the assessed acreages

5 A database table will be created of the resulting acreages which will be uploaded into the appraisal system All costs associated with software from both Tn-State and Data Systems Management, Inc. are included

Map Prints

Hard copy maps have been the primary source for parcel viewing for Clay County since the inception of the parcel maps. Tri-State understands the importance of hard copy maps therefore map prints will be provided in paper and pdf format. Tri-State will print 2 full size sets of maps with photos and 2 sets of half scale maps without photos. Printing of aerial imagery is costly do to the variations in color and the amount of ink necessary to print a single map. The county can use the pdf files to reproduce the hard copy map to make that available to the general public or the Appraiser.

Web-Based Maps

As an option, Tri-State can host your maps on the internet for a fee of \$250 per month with unlimited access to the county and general public We currently provide this service to 30 Mississippi counties This service not only provides a valuable public service but it also reduces traffic in the courthouse Additionally it is the most economical means of providing map data to all county departments as the fixed monthly fee provides access to an unlimited number of users

Hardware/Software

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For budgetary purposes no costs are included There are free viewing software packages available from ESRI that will run effectively on any reasonable PC Additionally it has a GPS feature where it can be used in a mobile environment Costs are provided for installation of Arc Reader on up to five (5) licenses and one day of onsite training

Flood Easement Layer

The existing flood data is currently available in a digital format for Clay County Tri-State will acquire that data and add in to the Geodatabase In order to add it to the Geodatabase as a layer it "will have to be formatted and structured to match the new Geodatabase
