Building better, faster broadband can connect every American to the future. From rural communities to city centers, new networks and more competition will benefit families, schools, libraries, health centers and small businesses.

This is a historic moment and preparing for broadband infrastructure projects is critical. The BroadLAND USA Checklist promotes public and private sector partnerships that are proven to speed deployment, save money, and connect communities to competition, innovation, and investment.



BROADBAND MONEY FOR BROADBAND PROJECTS: Focus application fees to actual, objectively reasonable costs incurred by the jurisdiction to process an application. Limit right-of-way access fees to the actual, objectively reasonable cost.



STREAMLINED FOR SPEED: Implement expedited or streamlined review of zoning and permitting applications that facilitate wireless and fiber deployment, including those that make efficient use of existing infrastructure pursuant to federal law.



TRANSPARENT REVIEW: Establish procedures to allow all forms, applications and documentation related to a project to be reviewed and either approved or denied within 30 days after the application is submitted. Adopt efficient intake procedures, such as batch permitting and electronic submission.



PRO INNOVATION: Empower next generation industries. Allow the use of innovative deployment processes and construction techniques, such as micro-trenching, that speed deployment and cut construction time. Promote investment in faster, future proof networks that are built to last and enable an “all of the above” deployment strategy.



SMART RESTORATION: It's important that broadband money is spent on broadband projects. By supporting smart street restoration obligations that are proportional to the scope of the construction required for the deployment and set at the time of the application, communities will maximize the benefits of their broadband dollars.

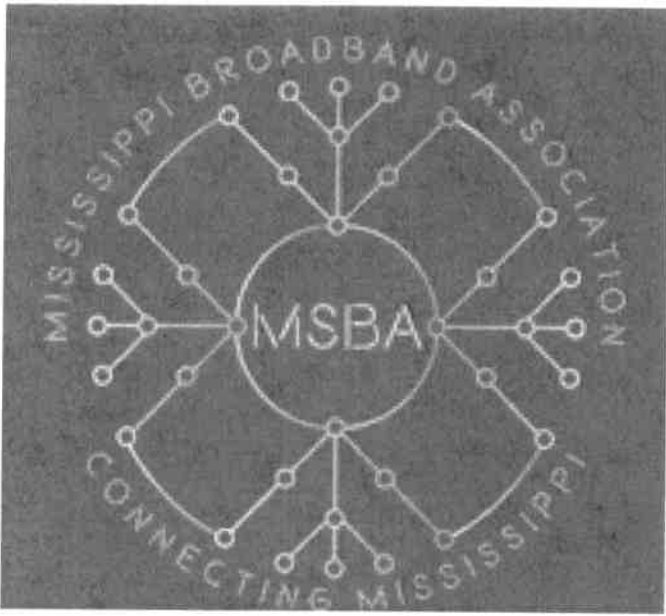

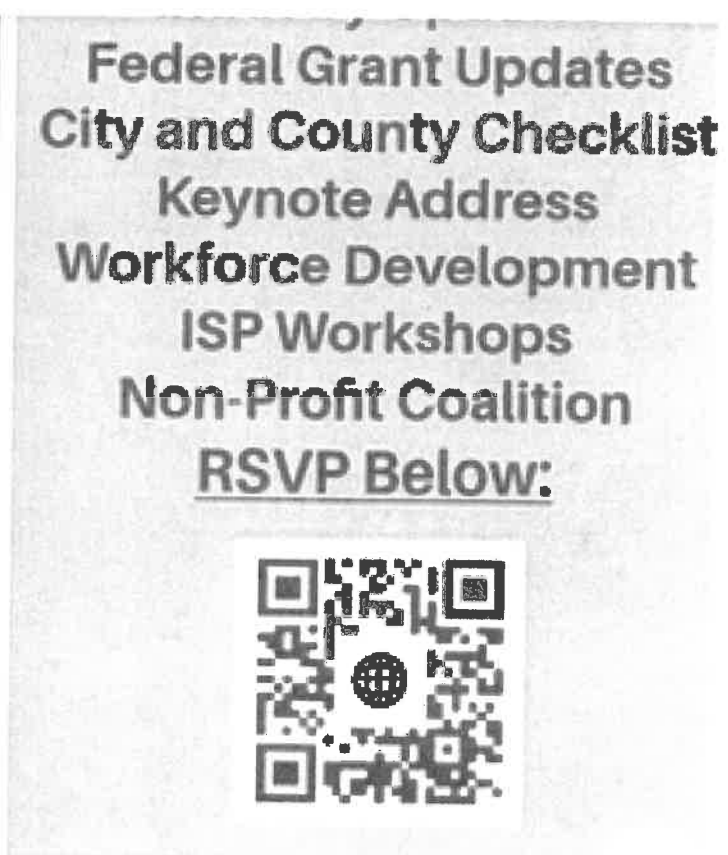
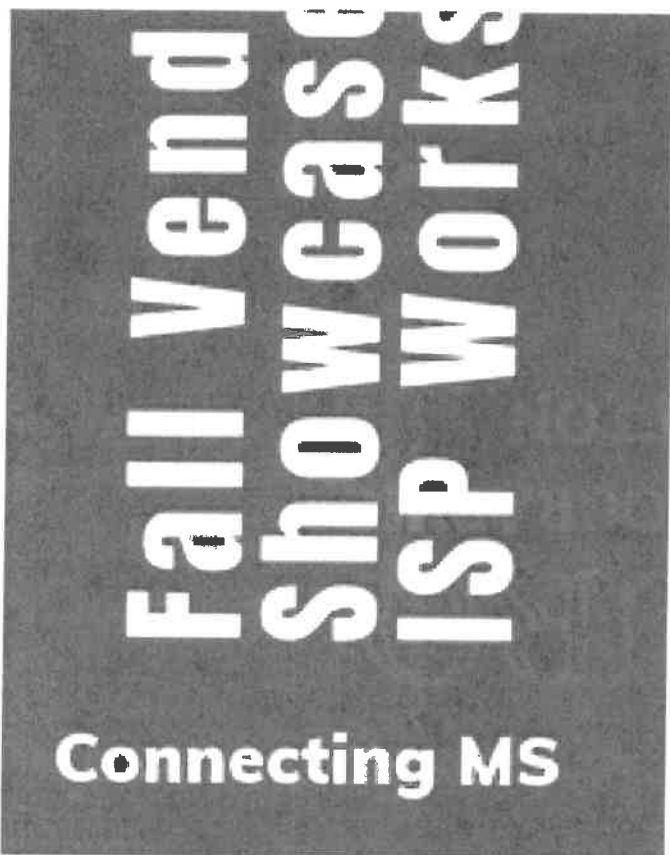

- Agriculture Agent: The Regional Coordinator said that it will be after the first of the year before filling the position is even considered. Lowndes and Oktibbeha have been without this agent for some time, and they may get filled sooner due to the county contributing a large portion of the salary. There is also a search for a new Extension Director, so this will slow things down a bit as well.
- The Regional Coordinator also said that the Office Associate Position should be filled by the first of October, or October 15 pending paperwork.
- The 4-H Agent in Oktibbeha has been recognized to be the agent that Clay County calls for any agriculture/forestry questions. Thad Moody 662-323-5916 The agent in Monroe County has been named to be the Interim County Coordinator. Randal Nevins 662-369-4951
- The Extension Office has continued to offer the scheduled programming that was already planned. Sew & Sew Textile Crafters met September 11. 4-H programming has still been taking place in the school. The Student Services Class has been trained in finance and then again had a practice program called "Real World" where they tested their skills for a month's budget by keeping their own bank ledger and paying bills. This training was September 12-15 and then again September 26-28.
- The County Office held its annual Exhibit Day. Attendance was a bit low with only 2 youths participating. The county will also be represented in the State Fair Poultry Show and Livestock Show by 2 youth. The office is currently getting them prepared and everything ready for October 14.
